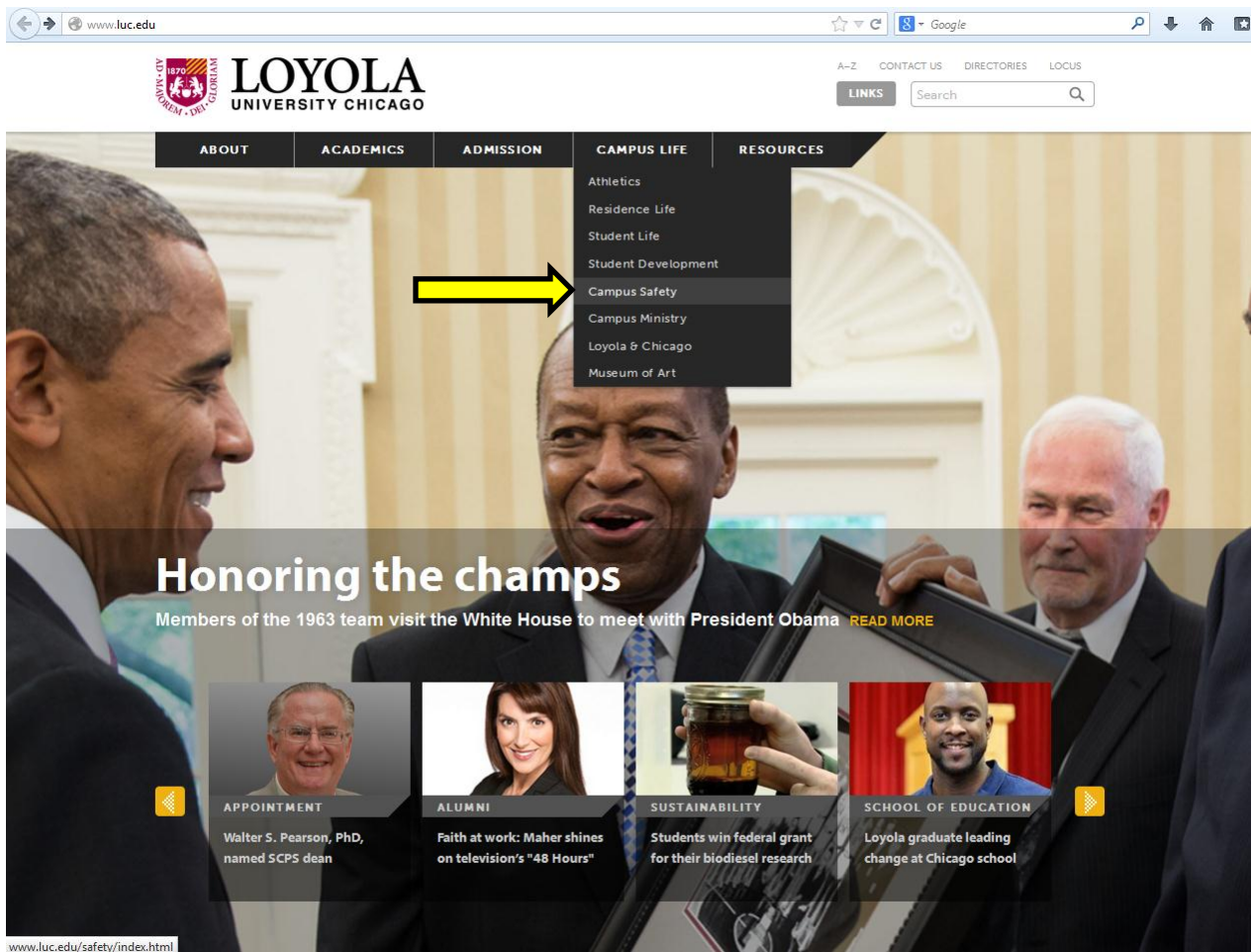


Loyola Alert

Here at Loyola University Chicago we have an emergency alert system, called Loyola Alert. This system will notify Faculty, Staff, and Students if there is a campus wide emergency. There will be a notification sent and it will contain information on the emergency that is taking place and safety procedures that should be taken place.

To get to the site to subscribe to Loyola Alert follow the instructions below. First, select Campus Safety on our homepage, luc.edu, under Campus Life.



Loyola University Chicago is launching Loyola Alert, a special service to provide personalized, time-sensitive alerts to students, faculty, staff and other personnel at Loyola's lakeside campuses in the event of unforeseen events or potentially life-threatening emergencies. Loyola Alert will immediately send messages to registered participants via the following communication channels:

- Voice messages to home phones/land lines and cell phones
- Text messages to cell phones
- Written messages to personal e-mail accounts

Sign-up is required for Loyola Alert emergency communications to be sent to individuals. Loyola Alert messages will be in addition to the university's emergency communications that are automatically sent to all LUC e-mail addresses and campus phone numbers, and made available on the LUC Website.

After logging in put in the information to complete the signing up process.
