Biographical History

Mary Louise Hirsh Burger was born November 3, 1932 in Chicago to Robert Stanley Hirsh and Margaret Agnes (Brennan). She married William Bronson Burger on March 16, 1968. Through her career Burger gained increasing influence and prominence in the field of childhood education at the local, national, and international levels. As a teacher in the Chicago Public School System between 1954 and 1968 she dealt with the education of children directly. Although this connection with children continued through her career, her focus took a more theoretical turn as Burger continued her own education through becoming increasingly involved in the development and accreditation of educational programs for children at both local and state levels. For example, she served for six years on the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) where one responsibility was as Chair of the Constitution Committee of the Executive Board. Burger also was involved with curriculum design for the Education Department while at Northeastern Illinois University.

In addition to teaching for the Chicago Public School System, Burger was also an instructor at DePaul University in the Education Department and Roosevelt University in Chicago in the Department of Creative Arts. In 1968, Burger joined the faculty of Northeastern Illinois University (NIU). She was professor in the Department of Childhood Education of NIU from 1968 – 1973, serving as Chairperson from 1972-1980. From 1986-1995 Burger served as Early Childhood Coordinator in the Department of Curriculum and Instruction. After 1985, she was a professor in the Department of Teacher Education/International-Intercultural. At NIU, Burger developed new courses including developing and presenting a graduate level course entitled "Curriculum in Early Childhood Education" which was broadcast over WBEZ-FM in Chicago.

Other professional experiences include working as a psychologist for Worthington, Hurst and Associates (1972-1974), Owner/Director Childhood Education Center, Evanston IL (1974–1985), and Educational Counselor, Burger Associates, Ltd., Schaumburg IL, from 1983 on.

Burger led many workshops and presented numerous papers at meetings of professional societies around the world on subjects such as coping with stress through children's literature, creative activities for young children, and toy safety. Although active in many international, national, and local professional organizations such as Zonta International, Delta Kappa Gamma International Society, North Shore Association of Nursery Schools, and the National Association for Education of Young Children, Burger was deeply involved in the Association for Childhood Education International (ACEI). She served the organization in many facets including several committees (such as the Infancy Committee, the Teacher Education Committee, as Co-Chair of the ACEI/Children's Book Council Committee (1981)), as Vice-President and member of the Executive board between 1983-1986, and as President between 1988-1992.

Burger has been listed in editions of World Who's Who of Women, Dictionary of International Biography, Who's Who of American Women, International Who's Who in Community Services, Who's Who Biographical Record of Child Development Professionals, Who's Who in the Midwest, Notable Americans of the Bicentennial Era, and Personalities of the West and Midwest.

Burger received her Bachelor of Arts degree from Mundelein College (1954) and her Master of Education degree from Loyola University Chicago (1957). She was awarded her Doctor of Education degree from Northern Illinois University (1972).

Dr. Mary Louise Hirsh Burger passed away on Sept. 8, 2018.

The materials in this collection include Mary Hirsh's Curriculum Vitae, biographical information and materials for Who's Who, writings and publications by Mary Hirsh (including her dissertation, papers, book reviews, and handwritten materials), photographs, information about her daycare and consulting endeavors, and personal correspondence.

The materials in this collection reflect activities at Northeastern Illinois University: not all the materials reflect activities in which Burger was involved either directly or indirectly. The papers include materials regarding general administrative and organizational activities at NIU, materials reflecting curriculum development, NIU news publications (including press releases, alumni news, and newsletters), and materials related to professional advancement at the university (many of these documents pertain to Burger).

Series 3: Childhood Education International, 1958-1995, n.d., Boxes 3-8

The materials in this series pertain to the professional organization, Association for Childhood Education International (ACEI). ACEI is an organization of teachers and education leaders that promotes the interests of children and their education through research, workshops, and publications. The materials reflect organizational activities and materials such as budgets, board

meeting minutes, by-laws, newsletters, and committee reports. There is also information reflecting international tours taken by members of ACEI where other schools and professionals were visited or observed. The series includes professional conference materials, primarily programs from the ACEI conferences. In addition, there are ACEI published materials including the organization professional journal, newsletters (particularly of smaller groups within the organizations such as the Division of Infancy), and the ACEI Exchange.

Series 4 Correspondence, 1970-1999, n.d., Boxes 9-11

This series contains correspondence written and received by Mary Burger. The subject of the correspondence reflects Burger's professional career, activities, and interests. Much of the correspondence pertains to ACEI and NIU, but not exclusively. There are greeting cards that have been housed in the series as well. The correspondence is arranged chronologically.

Series 5 Radio Course, 1971-1973, n.d., Boxes 12-14

This series contains materials pertaining to the course offered on WBEZ Radio by the Early Childhood Education Department of Northeastern Illinois University in cooperation with the Chicago Board of Education. Mary Louise Burger organized and conducted the course. According to the study guide the course "focuses upon various innovative curricular patterns involved in creative programs for young children designed to encourage individual progression in all areas of skill development." The course was broadcast on the radio Monday and Wednesday between 4:00 and 4:30 p.m. In addition there were seminars one Thursday each month. The series includes relevant documents for the course including a study as well as copies of all the sessions on reel-to-reel tapes.

Series 6 General Professional Conference, Organizational, and Publication Materials, 1977-1999, n.d., Boxes 15-16

This series contains materials from educational professional conferences and other organizations, with which Mary Louise Burger was involved.

Series 7 Awards, 1966-1994, n.d., Box 17
