Administrative History

Church Women United Rockford (CWUR) was a local unit of the larger national organization Church Women United (CWU). Founded in 1941, Church Women United is an ecumenical movement of church women of various denominations—including Protestant, Roman Catholic, and Orthodox—who work together to encourage a peaceful and just society. Church Women United identifies as "a racially, culturally, theologically inclusive Christian women's movement, celebrating unity in diversity and working for a world of peace and justice." As of 2011, there are over 1,200 local and state units of Church Women United in the US and Puerto Rico.

A local branch of CWU, Church Women United of Rockford began on February 3, 1921 when the missionary societies of various churches in the area met at the Court Street Methodist Church to form what they called The Women's Missionary Union of Rockford. The organization officially became part of the larger CWU in 1945. The women of CWUR participated in local meetings and state assemblies. The group also participated in local campaigns and activities, including Fall Forum, Spring Forum, and Love Tea. The women of CWUR worked with local non-profit organizations to address issues effecting women and children. With the Big Sisters of the Winnebago County, CWUR established and supported a home for girls, known as Forest Hall. Three national CWU events, World Day of Prayer (March), May Fellowship Day—later changed to May Friendship Day—(May), and World Community Day (November) are strongly represented in this collection. The minutes of annual meetings and board meetings, as well as financial statements and treasurer's reports make up a large portion of the collection. Church Women United of Rockford closed in 2012; its last meeting was held on March 2, 2012 at Allen Chapel A.M.E.

Scope of Context

Church Women United Rockford spans the years 1946-2012. The collection is arranged into four series: Administrative, Events, Audiovisual Materials, and Scrapbooks, Oversized, & 3-D Objects. The majority of the collection is within the administrative and events series which includes annual meeting minutes, board meeting minutes, financial records, and the organizations activities and celebrations. All series are arranged alphabetically.

Series 1: Administrative, 1956-2012, n.d., Box 1-2

Contains materials relating to the organization's administration including: bylaws, correspondence, financial documents, lists of members, and minutes of annual meetings and board meetings.

Series 2: Events, 1956-2012, n.d., Box 2

The majority of the material in this series relates to the three national CWU celebrations: May Fellowship (later Friendship) Day, World Community Day, and World Day of Prayer. Also included are materials related to Fall Forum, Love Tea, and Spring Forum.

Series 3: Audiovisual Materials, 2007, n.d., Box 3

This series contains slides featuring Cameroon, Panama, Paraguay, and Poland along with corresponding slide text for Panama, Paraguay, and Poland from World Day of Prayer presentations.

Series 4: Scrapbooks, Oversized, & 3-D Objects, 1946-1973, 1973-1992, 2006, n.d., Box 3-4

Three scrapbooks are contained in this series; the two oldest scrapbooks focus on the history of CWUR, while the newest scrapbook focuses on the members of CWUR and its events. The scrapbooks contain newspaper articles, event programs, membership lists, a text titled "History of the Rockford Council of Church Women," and photographs. Oversized material consists of budget sheets for 1967 and 2006.
