Administrative History

Church Women United Wilmette (CWUW) was a local unit of the larger national organization Church Women United (CWU). CWU was founded in 1941, and CWUW became incorporated into the national organization in 1946. CWUW was composed of women from different denominations, who participated in a fellowship which promoted community wide projects congruent with the Christian Church. Membership stipulations were that women of all churches of Wilmette were eligible.

CWUW members participated in local meetings, state assemblies, regional and national meetings. Typically the board of directors would be present at all gatherings. The group also participated in local campaigns and activities, as well as annual activities such as World Prayer Day, World Community Day, and May Fellowship. All activities and campaigns were aligned with the national CWU organization.

CWUW worked with the CWUI on various campaigns that included SERRV, the Dwight Correctional Center Chapel, and ethical choices for health care reform. CWUW acted as a catalyst to improve Wilmette, as well as society, in line with traditions and goals of the Christian Church.

Scope and Content

CWUW spans 1946-2007, with the majority of the records dating from 1970s to 2007. The collection is arranged into four thematic series: Administrative History, Activities & Campaigns, Publications, and Oversized Materials. All series are organized chronologically. The bulk of the

collection corresponds to the history and administrative history of CWUW which includes their board and meeting minutes, and the organizations activities and celebrations.

Series 1: Administrative History, 1947-2007, n.d, Boxes 1-4

Contains materials relating to the organizations history including: goals, board member duties, lists of board members and presidents, board meeting agendas and notes, and treasurer reports. Other materials include as well as unit handbooks, regional (east central), area (northeast), and state meeting information, revitalization efforts, and celebration agendas. The board meeting agendas, treasurer reports, and regional/state assemblies are divided by year and arranged chronologically. The financial activities of CWUW are included with the treasurer reports and bank statements. Some of the information correlates specifically with the goals and history of CWU and CWUI.

Series 2: Activities and Campaigns, 1983-2006, n.d., Boxes 4-7

Contains material relating to revitalization efforts and fundraisers put on by CWUW, specific campaigns and activities that the group participated in to improve their community, correspondences regarding the groups' activities, and the CWUW collaboration with the Evanston Chapters organization. A significant part of the CWUW and CWU in general, is their celebrations. Material regarding the World Day of Prayer, May Fellowship, and World Community Day are organized chronologically; and some years contain information on how to plan a celebration day.

Series 3: Publications, 1984-2007, n.d, Boxes 8-9

Includes the *Churchwoman*, *Illinois Interpreter*, *Church Women United in Greater Chicago*, *Church Women United in Northwest Cook County*, *CW Act*, *CW Inform*, *CW Act and Inform*, *Wellspring*, CWU Annual Reports, *Local Time*, Jubilee publications, Institute of Women Today, *Ecumenical Courier*, and miscellaneous publications that were sent to the CWUW chapter. Unfortunately these are not complete collections, and span a variety of years.

Series 4: Oversized materials, 1946-2004, n.d, Boxes 10-11

Includes posters for activities and celebrations, account ledger books, bound board meeting minutes, signature book from celebrations, prayer books and a video from the Ethical Choices in Healthcare campaign.
