Biographical History

Eleanor Frances Dolan was born in Cambridge, Massachusetts, May 30, 1907. Her parents are Harry Francis Roby and Lillie Eleanor (McFall) Dolan. She has one sister, Elizabeth M. Dolan of New York City. Eleanor F. Dolan received a B.A. (1927) from Wellesley College and her M.A. (1928) and Ph.D. (1935) from Radcliffe College. She served as an intern at Niantic Reformatory for Women. Dr. Dolan was an administrative assistant at Stephens College, secretary and research assistant in the Department of Government of Harvard University, and a Carnegie Scholar. She held a political science teaching position at Florida State College for Women from 1938 to 1939 and at New York University from 1939 to 1941. In 1941 Dr. Dolan became professor of government and dean of Flora Stone Mather College for Women of Western Reserve University. In 1950 Dr. Dolan joined the national staff of the American Association of University Women (AAUW).

As a specialist for higher education with the AAUW from 1950 to 1967, Dr. Dolan represented women's interests at many professional and other meetings, organized and managed an information retrieval service for women, and wrote and edited *Women's Education*. In addition, she organized and managed the AAUW's program for returning college women that provided financial aid to universities to prepare these women for professional positions in higher education. Financed by the Rockefeller Brothers Fund, this program was one of the first to identify and assist mature women back into the work force. Dr. Dolan traveled widely in implementing the program and wrote the 15-year

evaluation of the project, "With Half a Life to Live". During this period she also authored many articles on higher education for women in professional journals.

In 1967 Dr. Dolan joined the federal government as Specialist for Higher Education -- Graduate Academic Programs in the Bureau of Higher Education. She also had a special responsibility for women staff of the Bureau and joined in the final report, 1967 - 1975, on conditions for women in the Bureau and in all of the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare. After retiring from the Bureau of Higher Education in 1975, Dr. Dolan was a volunteer on the national staff of the International Women's Year, 1975 - 1976, writing part of their final report. In addition, she served as executive secretary of the National Council of Administrative Women in Education, 1975 - 1977, writing and editing their quarterly publication. In 1984 Dr. Dolan and Dorothy M. Gropp compiled *The Mature Woman in America: a selected annotated bibliography, 1979 - 1982*, published by the National Council on the Aging: Washington, D.C. (This volume is available at Loyola University's Cudahy Library.) During her lifetime, Dr. Dolan regularly participated in many national and local organizations for women and was a founder of Women's Equity Action League (WEAL). She resided in Alexandria, Virginia until her death on January 12, 1987.

Description of Materials as written by Eleanor Dolan on February 20, 1983

This collection covers the development of the women's movement and the status of women over the last 20 - 30 years. It is not exhaustive on any one topic. There are in it some books (hard and soft cover), but most of the collection is not books but ephemeral or fleeting material. Effort has been made to collect "ephemeral" or "fleeting" material – such as letters, reports, newspaper articles, periodicals, addresses, etc. As they are so often lost as soon as [they are] produced. I still continue to add to the collection.

The subjects covered have been those concerning the changing status of women, the development of women's lib, employment, organization data, government action, conferences on education, International Women's Year, aging, etc. The collection is uneven in coverage representing as it does merely my interest in women's affairs. Few books are included as no one could afford to keep up with the spate of publications on women in the last few years. However, classic statements are included, bibliographies and sample publications also. There are several hundred books and thousands of reports.

All sources and dates are noted. All are indexed and sorted and put into containers for easy use according to my system, but could easily be re-sorted to meet another's need. It is national in coverage. It is weak in topics such as rape, harassment, and abortion. Fleeting material, seemingly not too valuable now, but [value] increases with the years. The collection has the added value of having collected much data on a given topic all in one place. A list of topics is included; they should be used in an overlapping way.

Scope and Content

The Eleanor F. Dolan Collection dates from 1912 to 1993 and reflects her active concern for women, particularly women in higher education. International in scope, the material is often ephemeral in nature and includes letters, reports, newspaper articles, periodicals, addresses, bibliographies, and sample publications relating to women. In Dr. Dolan's own words, "...this collection covers the development of the women's movement and the status of women over the last 20/30 years." The bulk of the collection is from the 1950s to 1986.

The material is organized alphabetically and then chronologically within each category. At the collection end is an additional grouping of material listed only as Additional Material, 1912-1993, n.d. This material is organized as an addendum, alphabetically by subject.
