Provenance: Mary Sendra Anselmo, the Legion President at the time, donated the majority of the material on January 9, 2014 (WLA2014.1). Nancy Freeman, WLA director, and Laura Pearce, WLA graduate assistant, assisted in the packing and transport of the materials from the Legion of Young Polish Women offices at the Copernicus Center to the archives. Additional material was acquired in accessions WLA2014.5 (2 LFT), WLA2014.25 (4 LFT), and WLA2014.33 (0.25 LFT & 1,315 MB of digital material).

Separations: Approximately 5 linear feet of extraneous and duplicate materials were removed and discarded or returned to the Legion when the materials were accessioned. During processing, an additional 13 linear feet of mainly extraneous materials were removed and discarded or returned to the Legion.

Biographical/Administrative History

The Legion of Young Polish Women (Legion Młodych Polek or LMP) was founded in Chicago by Helen Lenard Pieklo and Adele Preyss (who became the organization's first president) on September 2, 1939 along with a group of 14-16 charter members. Founded as a non-profit organization in response to the German invasion of Poland on September 1, 1939, the Legion sought to provide assistance to the people of Poland during World War II. After the war ended, the Legion continued to provide support to Poles in Poland, the United States, and around the world.

In Poland, the Legion maintained a tradition of assistance, supporting medical institutions, universities, and homes for children and the elderly. The Legion supported the Solidarity Movement during the 1980s providing financial aid for the purchase of food, clothing, and medicine. Its "Medical Supplies to Poland" Project in the 1980s and 1990s provided over \$88,000 in assistance to small Polish clinics.

In the United States, the Legion helps ensure that Polish culture, heritage, and traditions retain a strong presence within the Polish-American community. In 1961, the Legion helped to establish the professorship of Polish Language and Literature as the University of Chicago and in recent years

has supported the Loyola University Chicago Polish Studies Program. The Legion supports the Polish Museum of America, Polish-American arts organizations, Polish language schools, and many scholarship funds. The needs of new immigrants from Poland are addressed through assistance to the Polish American Association and the Polish American Congress Charitable Foundation. The Legion's concerns reach out beyond its ethnic scope, as evidenced by donations to the Little Brothers – Friends of the Elderly the Special Olympics, Ronald McDonald House, and the Salvation Army.

Over the 75 years of the Legion's existence, the organization has funded over \$1,400,000.00 of charitable and cultural projects in Chicago, the United States, Poland, and everywhere in the world where there has been a need to aid Poles and promote Polish culture.

The Legion's main fundraising event, the annual White and Red Ball, has been a major social event of Chicago's Polish community since it was first held in 1940. The iconic Presentation of Debutantes was added to the ball in 1945 and has continues to be a rite of passage for young Polish women in and around Chicago to this day.

Scope and Content

The Legion of Young Polish Women Records consists of materials spanning the years 1939-2014, with the bulk of materials from approximately 1980-2007. Records contain correspondence, meeting minutes, ledgers, financial documents, reports, event information, newspapers, many photographs and scrapbooks, as well as some audio-visual and 3D materials. Many individual records are written in Polish; series containing documents in Polish are noted below and individual folders containing records in Polish are marked. All series are arranged alphabetically and subsequently by date, where applicable, unless otherwise noted. Additional information is available for interviews found in Series 7 as well as some of the ephemera items in Subseries 8A, this information can be found at the end of this document in Appendix A-C.

Series 1: Administrative Materials, 1939-2012, n.d., Boxes 1-6

This series contains awards and certificates, constitutions, articles of incorporation, histories, logos and stationary, meeting minutes and meeting attendance notebooks, membership and officer lists, committee reports, and administrative documents related to the Copernicus Foundation. Series contains documents that are in English and Polish.

Subseries 1A: Awards & Certificates, 1940, 1966-2003, n.d., Box 1

Contains certificates and awards presented to the Legion of Young Polish Women; documents are in both Polish and English. Additional oversized and framed certificates, as well as plaques and trophies, can be found in Series 8: Subseries 8A.

Subseries 1B: Copernicus Foundation, 1982-2002, n.d., Box 1

This subseries consists of administrative materials related to the Copernicus Foundation and includes meeting minutes & agendas, reports, financial statements, and the rental agreement between the Legion of Young Polish Women and the Copernicus Foundation.

Subseries 1C: Governing Documents, 1939-2008, Box 1

Subseries contains constitutions & by-laws, proposed revisions to these documents, and official copies of the articles of incorporation.

Subseries 1D: Histories, 1939-1994, n.d., Box 1

Contains documents outlining the history of the Legion of Young Polish Women as well as a pamphlet created by the Polish American Historical Society in 1939 titled "What Happened with Poland;" subseries contains one document written in Polish.

Subseries 1E: Logos, 2008-2012, n.d., Box 1

Contains letterhead & envelopes, patent and trademark materials, and sketches (with labels in Polish).

Subseries 1F: Meeting Minutes & Attendance, 1948-1949, 1970-2012, n.d., Boxes 1-4 This subseries includes board meeting and general meeting minutes as well as notebooks containing meeting minutes and meeting attendance lists.

Subseries 1G: Membership, 1939, 1965-2013, n.d., Boxes 4-5

Contents include: membership applications and registration forms, membership lists and directories, membership cards, suspensions, and information about individual members (some of which is in Polish). Additional digital content pertaining to individual member Eugenia Miczko is available. Please see an archivist for access to digital content (N:drive → Collection Files → Legion of Young Polish Women → Digital Content).

Subseries 1H: Officers & Committees, 1939-2007, n.d., Boxes 5-6

Subseries contains lists of officers and committee members, reports from officers and committees, inventories completed by the outgoing President, and officer manuals. Materials in this subseries are in both English and Polish.

Series 2: Correspondence, 1939-2013, n.d., Boxes 6-24

Series consists of correspondence both to and from the Legion, the bulk of which relate to requests for financial assistance in some form. Because original order has been maintained whenever possible, correspondence can also be found in Series 3 (financial correspondence) and Series 5 (event specific correspondence). The majority of the folders in this series contain correspondence in both English and Polish.

Subseries 2A: General Correspondence, 1939-2009, n.d., Boxes 6-24

The larger of the two subseries, the correspondence in this subseries are arranged chronologically. The original order of the correspondence has been maintained wherever possible. This has led to a slight difference in the organization of individual folders within this subseries. Some folders represent correspondence reviewed at specific monthly meetings (as indicated in folder title) while others consist of correspondence written in a given period. Most folders contain materials in both English and Polish.

Subseries 2B: Topical Correspondence, 1981-2013, n.d., Box 24

The correspondence in this subseries were originally organized by subject, rather than date, and this organizational structure has been maintained. Folders are arranged topically in alphabetical order.

Series 3: Financials, 1939-2009, n.d., Boxes 24-31

Series contains information related to LMP financials. Documents include financial correspondence, bank and account information, donation records, dues information, ledger books, treasurer's reports, reports and receipts related to events, and tax documents.

Subseries 3A: Banks & Accounts, 1977-2008, n.d., Box 24

This subseries contains documents related to various banks and accounts used by the Legion, types of information within this subseries include correspondence, account applications, account tax statements, contracts, bond schedules, account booklets and statements, and safety deposit box inventories.

Subseries 3B: Donations, 1939, 1943, 1978-1997, n.d., Boxes 24

Subseries contains various kinds of materials recording donations made by the Legion to other organizations.

Subseries 3C: Dues Information, 1987-2007, n.d., Boxes 24-25

Subseries includes lists, notebooks, and receipt books noting members who have paid their dues as well as lists of members who have not paid dues.

Subseries 3D: Event Financials, 1939-2009, n.d., Boxes 25-27

Materials in this subseries relate to events held by the Legion of Young Polish Women. Documents here include receipts, reports, invoices, and bill. One-time events, such as picnics, fashion shows, and benefit concerts are represented as well as reoccurring annual events such as the Swietojanki picnic and the White and Red Ball. Because original order was maintained whenever possible, financial information about the Swietojanki picnic, the White and Red Ball, and various anniversary celebrations can be found in Series 5 as well. This subseries contains documents in both English and Polish.

Subseries 3E: General Bills & Expenses, 1980-1981, 2000-2009, n.d., Box 27

Subseries contains bills, notes, reports, and invoices for general expenses not associated with specific events. These expenses include printing costs, rent, insurance, refreshments for meetings, tickets to events held by other organizations, and office supplies.

Subseries 3F: Ledges, 1939-1943, 1978-2003, n.d., Boxes 27-29

Subseries contains ledger books and sheets kept by the treasurer documenting income, expenses, dues, and other financial information. Materials within this subseries are arranged chronologically.

Subseries 3G: Tax Documents, 1939-2004, Box 30

This subseries contains all tax related documents including annual reports, income tax returns, correspondence, tax exemption applications, and tax preparation materials.

Subseries 3H: Treasurer's Reports, 1941-2009, n.d., Boxes 30-31

Materials within this subseries include audits, reports, and report notebooks, created by the treasurer. This subseries contains some documents which are written only in Polish.

Series 4: Publications, 1939-2007, n.d., Boxes 31-35

This series contains published materials created by the Legion as well as by outside organizations. Materials include newsletters, books, newspapers, newspaper clippings, pamphlets, brochures, magazines, booklets, and annual reports. This series contains documents written in both English and Polish.

Subseries 4A: Legion Publications, 1977, 1993-1995, n.d., Box 31

Contains two copies of *Kosciuszko Letters in the American Revolution*, a book published by the Polish Museum of America with the aid of the Legion of Young Polish Women, as well as Legion newsletters.

Subseries 4B: Newspapers & Newspaper Clippings, 1939-2003, n.d., Boxes 31-32

This subseries contains copies of Polish language newspapers, newspaper clippings about LMP events from English and Polish newspapers, and other clippings saved by members of the Legion. Because original order has been maintained wherever possible, newspaper articles about specific events and activities can also be found in Series 5. Newspapers and newspaper clippings in this subseries are written in both English and Polish.

Subseries 4C: Outside Publications, 1966-2007, n.d., Boxes 32-35

This subseries contains materials published by outside organizations or individuals and sent to the Legion of Young Polish Women. The majority of the organizations represented are Polish-American organizations, but also include non-Polish organizations that worked with or received support from the Legion. Materials include books, pamphlets, booklets, newsletters, brochures, magazines, and annual reports. Folders are arranged alphabetically by affiliated organization (where possible) or by the title of the publication. This subseries contains documents written in both English and Polish.

Series 5: Activities, 1939-2014, n.d., Boxes 35-60

Documents in this series pertain to Legion activities and events as well as the activities and events of related organizations attended by Legion members. Materials include invitations, scholarship applications, reports, event programs, correspondence, financial documents, newspaper clippings. Documents are in both English and Polish.

Subseries 5A: Causes, 1940, 1961-2011, n.d., Box 35

Subseries contains information related to various causes championed by the Legion including sending Ambulances to Poland during WWII, various scholarship funds, relief efforts, and the Polish Language Chair at the University of Chicago. Types of materials include invitations, scholarship applications, lists of scholarship recipients, project proposals, programs, correspondence, and newspaper clippings. Documents in this subseries are written in both English and Polish.

Subseries 5B: General Events, 1939-2009, n.d., Boxes 35-38

This subseries consists of materials related to Legion events and includes items such as reports, correspondence, financials, invitations, programs, flyers, and raffle tickets. Additional financial information for individual events can also be found in Subseries 3D: Event Financials. Binders related to individual events were deconstructed and their contents were transferred to folders; original order was maintained during this process. Documents related to the annual White and Red Ball can be found in Subseries 5E: White and Red Ball. This subseries contains materials written in both English and Polish.

Subseries 5C: Medical Supplies to Poland, 1987-1996, n.d., Boxes 38-41

This subseries contains materials related to the Legion's project to send medical supplies to clinics in Poland. Materials include reports, lists of items shipped, shipping invoices, receipts, letters of acknowledgement and thank you notes. Much of the material in this subseries was originally organized in binders for each shipment which were deconstructed and the original order maintained. The majority of the materials in this subseries are written in Polish, but all reports are in English.

Subseries 5D: Outside Organizations, 1965-2007, n.d., Boxes 41-44

Subseries contains documents that pertain to activities and events from other (mainly Polish) organizations that were either attended or supported by the Legion. Materials include programs, invitations, brochures, correspondence, and flyers. Documents in this subseries are written in English and Polish.

Subseries 5E: White and Red Ball, 1940-2014, n.d., Boxes 44-60

Materials in this subseries relate to the Legion's annual White and Red Ball and include reports, program books, guidelines, invitations, correspondence, newspaper articles, financial statements, and invoices. Binders devoted to each White and Red Ball were deconstructed and their contents were transferred to folders; original order was maintained during this transfer. Items are arranged alphabetically by topic, with documents related to individual balls arranged chronologically. This subseries contains material in both English and Polish.

Series 6: Photographs, 1940-2011, n.d., Boxes 60-69

This series contains photographs of Legion-sponsored events and activities as well as the events of other organizations that were attended by LMP members. Identification information for photographs is in both English and Polish. Additional photographs can also be found in many of the scrapbooks in subseries 8B.

Subseries 6A: White and Red Ball, 1951-2009, n.d., Box 62-63

Subseries contains professional and personal photographs from the annual White & Red Ball, ball publicity photos, and photos from the debutante teas. Subseries contains identification information for photographs in both English and Polish. Additional photographs were donated to the archives in a digital format. Digital content includes White & Red Ball 2014 photographs. Please see an archivist for access to digital content (N:drive \rightarrow Collection Files \rightarrow Legion of Young Polish Women \rightarrow Digital Content \rightarrow AMARANTOWY Dla Legionu, 2014).

Subseries 6B: Photo Albums, 1949-1997, n.d. Boxes 63-69

This subseries contains photographs originally held in photo albums. Photographs were removed from albums for preservation and original order was maintained as much as possible. Subseries contains photographs of events such as White & Red Balls, Debutante Teas, Swietojanki festival, and Anniversary Balls as well as albums created by specific individuals. Folders are labeled by the name of the album (where applicable) or a description of its contents.

Series 7: Audio-Visual Materials, 1972, 1987-2013, n.d., Boxes 69-76

Contents of this series include audio cassette tapes, electronic discs, films, video cassette tapes, and video cassette tape masters. Each type of material is broken up into its own subseries which are arranged chronologically. See a staff member for access to equipment to play any audio-visual material.

Subseries 7A: Audio Cassette Tapes, 1993, Box 69

Subseries contains one audio cassette tape labeled "LMP March" and dated 1993.

Subseries 7B: Electronic Discs, 2009-2013, Box 69

Subseries contains DVDs of White and Red Balls.

Subseries 7C: Films, 1972, n.d., Boxes 70-71

Subseries contains two reel-to-reel films.

Subseries 7D: Interviews, 2014, Box 69

This subseries contains digital audio files and associated paperwork for interviews conducted in July and August of 2014 by Laura Pearce, WLA graduate assistant, with members and supporters of the Legion of Young Polish Women. For more information about the individuals interviewed, see Addendum A. Subseries 7E: Video Cassette Tapes, 1987, 2001-2004, Boxe 72

Subseries contains video cassettes of event footage from the Swietojanki picnic in 1987 and from a number of White & Red Balls.

Subseries 7F: Video Cassette Tape Masters, 1987-1992, Boxes 72-76

Subseries contains video cassette tape masters containing footage from a number of White & Red Balls as well as Swietojanki picnics, and LMP History. The LMP History tapes have been digitized and are available to researchers. For more information about the content of these tapes, see Addendum B. Please see an archivist to access these files (External Hard drive). Unfortunately, the WLA does not currently have a means of playing Video Cassette Masters and so the Swietojanki and White & Red Ball tapes are not accessible to researchers at this time.

Series 8: Scrapbooks, Oversized & 3-D Material, 1939-2011, n.d., Boxes 77-102, Flat File 9 This series contains oversized documents and certificates as well as 3-dimensional objects such as buttons, medallions, trophies, plaques, jewelry, and stamps. A vast array of scrapbooks are also included. This series contains materials written in English and Polish.

Subseries 8A: Oversized Documents & 3-D Materials, 1940-2011, n.d., Boxes 77-88, Flat File 9

Contents of this subseries include framed and oversized certificates, trophies, buttons, plaques, medallions, commemorative coins, jewelry, stamps, a seal, and oversized photographs. Materials are arranged by general categories: plaques and framed certificates, trophies, and other and are arranged chronologically within each category. Certificates and plaques are written in English as well as in Polish. See Appendix C at the end of this Finding Aid for additional information about some of the ephemera, items with additional information are marked with an asterisks (*).

Subseries 8B: Scrapbooks, 1939-2006, n.d., Boxes 89-102

This subseries contains scrapbooks and scrapbook binders. Many of the scrapbooks contain newspaper clippings, portions of event programs, invitations, and photographs. The majority of the scrapbooks were created by members of the Legion of Young Polish Women, most notably by the historian, while a few of were created by outside organizations and given to the Legion. Materials are arranged chronologically by date of contents. Contents of scrapbooks are in English and Polish.

Maria Ciesla, a former debutante and past president of the Legion wrote on July 19, 2014: "The mermaid indicates it is not official or from the Polish government. It might have represented an anniversary of the city of Warsaw, as mermaid is its symbol, or a gift from the AK Polish Army Veterans."

Rose Necklace, n.d.

Maria Ciesla, a former debutante and past president of the Legion wrote on July 19, 2014: "The rose pendants were not given to debs to my knowledge [the graduate student processing the records had hypothesized they might have been], but were given as a gift to Past presidents by President Raczynska at one of the anniversaries. Had to be in the 90s. I have mine."
