Administrative History

In 1997, the Gannon Center for Women and Leadership of Loyola University Chicago sponsored the creation of a collection of historical essays about Mundelein College, the last four-year women's college in Illinois. This project became the book *Mundelein Voices*. The co-directors of the book project included Sr. Ann Harrington, BVM and Prudence Moylan and other participating members included Paula Pfeffer, Sr. Joan Frances Crowley, BVM, Sr. Mary DeCock, BVM, and Sr. Carolyn Farrell, BVM. The essays in the book were written by former faculty, administrators and students. The book aims to put Mundelein College in a historical perspective as Illinois' last remaining college for women, celebrate the achievements of Mundelein faculty, staff and students and remember the spirit of Mundelein following its 1991 affiliation with nearby Loyola University Chicago.

Scope and Content

This collection spans from 1997 to 2002 with some undated material. The bulk of the records relate to the creation of the book including contracts, authors, publication, research, and publicity. Additional material includes limited audiovisuals: photographs, video and audio recording of a book discussion held at Loyola University Chicago. The materials are organized alphabetically.

In 2013, Sister Ann Harrington donated a small amount of records regarding *Mundelein Voices* that were incorporated into the collection.

Contains materials the bulk of the collection materials including contracts, authors, publication, research, contracts, drafts, research, and publicity.
