Biographical/Administrative History

The OSCLG was created in 1978 at Bowling Green State University as a forum for professional discussion, presentation, and promotion of research in the areas of communication, language, and gender. Annual conferences, which are held at different universities each year, provide the forum for such activity. The first conference was held in 1978.

OSCLG has an international membership which includes teachers, researchers, consultants, and community practitioners. They come together at the annual conferences, where they present and hear paper presentations, take part in panel discussions, and listen to guest speakers. The organization presents awards for outstanding theses, books, and published articles. OSCLG has published anthologies of the research presented at its conferences.

OSCLG's first president, Linda A.M. Perry, Ph.D., was appointed in 1988. The organization is governed by an executive committee consisting of present and past officers, conference directors, and elected members. In 1991, the journal *Women & Leadership* became affiliated with OSCLG. This publication, from the Communications Department at George Mason University, serves as a feminist arena for discussion. The journal's mission is to provide a feminist forum for those interested in communication, language and gender. OSCLG also publishes its own newsletter, *Women & Leadership News*.

Scope and Content

This collection has been divided into six series; the OSCLG collection consists of 10 linear ft. and span the years 1966 to 2008. It consists of academic papers, journals, newsletters, membership lists, correspondence, membership lists, photographs, books, and a video tape of a panel discussion. The collection is organized chronologically within each series.

Series 1: Organizational, 1966-2006, n.d., Boxes 1-2
