Biographical History

Olivia Petrides is a working artist and professor living in Chicago IL. Petrides received her BA from Kalamazoo College in Kalamazoo, Michigan in English Literature. She received her MFA from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago where she is currently an Adjunct Associate Professor in the Painting and Drawing Department and the Visual Communications Department. Petride's art has been on exhibit in galleries and museums in Iceland, the Faroe Islands, Scotland, Seattle, Washington D.C. and Chicago. Her works are included in the public collections of the Smithsonian Institution, the United States Park Service, the Field Museum, the Illinois State Museum, Openlands Preservation Association, and Iceland's Hafnorborg Institute of Art. Throughout her career she has been awarded many grants and artist residences, most notably the Fulbright Grant in 1993.

From 1983 to 1987, Petrides was a member of Artemisia Gallery, an internationally recognized women's cooperative founded in 1973. During her involvement, Petrides curated two exchange exhibits between Icelandic women artists and Artemisia members both in Chicago and at the Living Art Museum in Reykjavik, Iceland. Petrides also curated an exchange exhibit between artists from the Faroe Islands. Petrides is also the illustrator for two series of monographs entitled "Trees of the US," and "Peterson Field Guides" both written by her father, George A Petrides.

Scope and Content

The Olive Petrides Papers consists of two boxes, spanning the years 1983-2014. This collection is divided into three sections: Professional, Monograph and Audiovisual and is arranged alphabetically.

Series 1: Professional, 1983-2014, n.d., Box 1

Contains materials relating to Petrides' professional art career including exhibition postcards and press releases, Artemisia materials, media coverage of Petrides' exhibitions and art, exhibition publications, one portfolio of a painting series, a biography and resume.

Series 2: Monograph, 1992-2005, Box 2

Contains six field guides, two being Peterson Field Guides and four from a series called *Trees of the US* all written by George A. Petrides and illustrated by Olivia Petrides.

Contains three slide boxes that include a series of illustrations from *Peterson's Field Guide to Western Trees*, and slides of oil and watercolor paintings. The slides to the Peterson's Field Guide were reorganized by plate number and the painting slides were reorganized by painting series.
