Biographical History

Susan Sensemann was born October 6, 1949 in Glen Cove, New York. She graduated from Syracuse University in 1971 with a BFA in Printmaking and went on to earn her MFA in Painting at the Tyler School of Art at Temple University. As an associate professor, Sensemann taught at the University of Illinois-Champaign (U of I) from 1973 until 1981 with a focus on painting and drawing. She began teaching at the University of Illinois-Chicago (UIC) in 1981 where she served as the Director of Undergraduate Studies at the School of Art and Design from 2000 until 2005. Previously, Sensemann was the Studio Arts Coordinator at U of I from 1983 until 1984 and the Director of Graduate Studies for the School of Art and Design at UIC from 1989 until 1991. Sensemann is now Professor Emerita at UIC.

As an artist, Sensemann has focused on a variety of subjects including the structure and psychological implications depicted in works by Italian pre-Renaissance artists. She has also used her art to investigate a gothic narrative structure within a tradition of feminist self-portraiture. Another topic of her artwork is the combination of her photography with Nathanial Hawthorne's poetry. Through the use of photography, drawing, sculpture, and primarily painting, Sensemann has built a long career of art in various forms.

In 1993, Sensemann joined Artemisia, a women artists' cooperative in Chicago. Founded in 1973, Artemisia supported the careers of over 150 women artists and exhibiting guest artists by providing a community and exhibition space outside of traditional, male-dominated institutions until it closed in 2003. Sensemann cites her membership as influential and credits it with her promotion to full

professor at UIC. During her time with Artemisia, she wrote grants and fostered the mentorship program for the gallery.

Sensemann is also a community arts advocate, working for many years on a mentorship program for emerging artists. From this program, she developed an international exchange program with artists throughout the world, including Germany, China, and Finland.

The recipient of numerous awards and fellowships throughout her career, Sensemann earned the Illinois Arts Council Visual Arts Fellowship and the Silver Circle Award from UIC. She also received grants to fund international programs, such as a MUCIA Grant to South Korea, a British Arts Council Grant for Belfast, and Chicago Artists International Program Grants to Prague and Turku, Finland. Her work has given her the opportunity to lecture at institutions in Italy, Germany, Korea, China, and across the United States.

Scope and Content

The Susan Sensemann Papers consist of 11 boxes, spanning the years 1969 to 2011. This collection is divided into three sections: Biographical, Professional and Visual/Oversized. The professional series is divided into four subseries: Academics, Art and Exhibitions, Travel, and Press. There are numerous slides and photographs in the collection, as well as some oversized materials. The collection spans the years 1969-2011 and is organized alphabetically.

Series 1: Biographical, 1988-2005, n.d., Box 1

Contains materials relating to Sensemann's personal life. Included are artist's statements, resumes, and biographies.

Series 2: Professional, 1969-2009, n.d., Boxes 1-7

Contains materials related to Sensemann's career as an artist, professor, and activist.

Subseries 2A: Academics, 1971-2000, n.d. Boxes 1-2

This material is related to Sensemann's academic career at UIUC and UIC. It includes awards, promotions, teaching materials, evaluations, and correspondence.

Subseries 2B: Art and Exhibitions, 1970-2011, n.d. Boxes 2-6

The bulk of this subseries is made up of exhibition materials such as cards and booklets from Sensemann's numerous exhibits. Her artwork is featured in many of the publications included. Various other aspects of her artistic career are a part of this section, including gallery information, correspondence, essays, and other similar material.

Subseries 2C: Travel, 1984-1999, n.d. Boxes 6-7

Documentation relating to Sensemann's international travel is part of this subseries. One of the most extensive segments of this section is the information regarding the United Nations Fourth World Conference on Women in Beijing.

Subseries 2D: Press, 1969-2005, n.d. Box 7

The majority of this subseries are newspaper and magazine articles about or featuring Sensemann's artwork throughout her career. There are also many articles relating to the UN World Conference on Women and women's rights in China. Additional press is located in the oversized series.

Series 3: Audiovisual/Oversized, 1970-2009, n.d. Boxes 7-11

Spanning four boxes, this series contains many photographs, three scrapbooks, and over fifteen hundred slides. The provenance of the original slide order is maintained. It also consists of oversized materials, including illustrations, a catalogue, and newspapers, primarily related to the UN Conference on Women.
