Biographical Sketch

John Edward Festle, S.J. was born on July 28th 1925, in Chicago, Illinois, one of four sons born to Katherine and John Edward Festle Sr. He attended grammar school at Our Lady of Lourdes from 1930 to 1938 and high school at Loyola Academy in Chicago between 1938 and 1942. Festle entered the Society of Jesus soon after high school graduation, on August 8th 1942, and subsequently entered Seminary at Xavier University in Cincinnati (1942-1946). From 1946 to 1949 he attended West Baden College at Loyola University Chicago, receiving his B.A. in Latin and Greek (1947) his Licentiate of Philosophy (1949) and his M.A. in Greek (1949). Between the years of 1949 and 1953 he studied at Oxford University, receiving a second B.A. in Latin and Greek Literature. Festle then studied Theology at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, receiving his Licentiate of Sacred Theology in 1957. Throughout the course of his academic pursuits, he also studied at the University of Fribourg in Switzerland (1950), the American School of Classical Studies in Athens (1952), the Vergilian School in Cuma, Italy (1956), and the Villa S. Ignazio in Florence, Italy (1957-1958).

He received his first teaching appointment in 1958, in the Classical Studies Department of the Milford College of Liberal Arts at Xavier University. In 1961 he was promoted from Instructor to Assistant Professor, and in 1966 to Associate Dean of Milford College. Additionally, he served as the Milford College Librarian throughout his time at Xavier (1958-1966) and traveled as a visiting professor, holding positions at Loyola University Chicago (1962-1963; 1965), Fordham (1963) and Gonzaga (1964).

In February of 1966 Festle began his career at Loyola University of Chicago as an Assistant Professor of Classical Studies. Fluent in Latin, Ancient Greek, and Italian, he would go on to teach several graduate and undergraduate courses in the classics throughout his academic career. He was promoted to Associate Director of the Honors Program in 1968, Freshman Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences in 1975, and

Associate Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences in 1977. Festle also became involved in Loyola University's Rome Center, teaching there for the 1969-1970 school year and subsequently assisting in programming throughout the remainder of his Loyola career.

Throughout his career, Festle remained active in the greater academic community, both nationally and internationally. He often gave lectures, published frequently in his area of study, and served as delegate to several conferences, including the International Conference on Classical Studies in Bonn, West Germany (1969), the National Association of Honors Councils in Williamsburg, Maryland (1973) and the Illinois Council for Humanities and Public Issues (1974). Additionally, Festle remained actively involved in the Jesuit community, giving frequent sermons, serving as Loyola's Jesuit delegate to the Province Assembly of the Chicago Province (1976), and helming and participating in multiple religious retreats. He also occasionally wrote prose and poetry as a hobby.

Upon being diagnosed with cancer of the tongue, and eventually lymphoma, Festle took a leave of absence from his position at Loyola in 1982. He never regained his health and passed away in Chicago, at the age of 58, on November 12, 1983.

Scope and Content

The papers of John E. Festle, S.J comprise 8.5 linear feet and span the years 1932-1983, with the bulk encompassing 1965-1981. The collection consists of personal and familial records, professional correspondence, academic research and teaching materials, committee minutes, sermons and lectures, and university records. Each series of this collection is arranged chronologically, with the exception of Committees, which is arranged alphabetically and then chronologically within each separate committee. Committees include the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) Academic Council, CAS Core Curriculum, CAS Faculty Council, Danforth, Foreign Culture, Lewis Towers Honors Program, Rhodes Scholarship, Space, Sue Nebel Core Literature, Undergraduate Scholarships and Undergraduate Admissions.

Series 1: Personal Records, 1932-1983, no date, Boxes 1-2

This series contains records in relating to Festle's personal life, including correspondence with family members and close friends, childhood school papers, prose and poetry, personal desk calendars, ordination and silver jubilee materials, and Curriculum Vitae documents.

Series 2: Professional Correspondence, 1965-1982, no date Boxes 3-4

This series is composed of correspondence which relates to Festle's academic career, including his various positions and engagements at Loyola, and to the Jesuit community. The correspondence has been arranged by topic rather than addressee.

Series 3: Jesuit Activities, 1955-1982, no date, Boxes 4-5

This series contains documents relating to Festle's work as a Jesuit, including notes from sermons and lectures and addresses, ministry pieces, retreat materials, agendas and minutes from meetings of the Loyola Jesuit community, and Bylaws and Statutes from the Jesuit Board of Trustees.

Series 4: Classical Studies Department, 1964-1983, no date, Box 6

This series is composed of documents which pertain to Festle's work in Loyola's Classical Studies department, including meeting notes, annual reports, course surveys and information, notes on syllabus design, and evaluations.

Series 5: Academic Research, 1939-1982, no date, Boxes 7-8

This series is composed of documents pertaining to Festle's personal academic pursuits, including academic papers, documents and notes utilized in various research, and a collection of articles about education.

Series 6: Teaching Materials, 1949-1978, no date, Boxes 9-11

This series is composed of materials used in the instruction of Festle's various Classics courses. It includes assorted annotated copies of classic works, photocopied articles and papers, syllabi, lecture notes and outlines, supplementary course materials (including photographs), and the dissertation and corresponding notes of Donald J. McGuire (1975-1976), for which Festle served as advisor.

Series 7: Freshman Dean Records, 1975-1977, Box 12

This series is comprised of records pertaining to Festle's tenure as Freshman Dean for the College of Arts and Sciences at Loyola, including correspondence relating to his initial appointment, a North Central Visitation report, housing questionnaires and class statistics.

Series 8: College of Arts and Sciences Dean Records, 1946-1981, Boxes 12-13

This series is comprised of records pertaining to Festle's tenure as Associate Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at Loyola, including notes, documents and photographs relating to the expansion of 10 E. Pearson, memos, student reports and dean's lists, advisor rosters, questionnaires, and departmental statistics.

Series 9: Committees, 1968-1981, Boxes 13-20

This series contains notes, documents and minutes pertaining to the various committees Festle sat upon throughout the course of his Loyola career, including the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) Academic Council, CAS Core Curriculum, CAS Faculty Council, Danforth, Foreign Culture, Lewis Towers Honors Program, Rhodes Scholarship, Space, Sue Nebel Core Literature, Undergraduate Scholarships and Undergraduate Admissions. This series also contains the proposal put together by a committee attempting to implement a Women's Studies program at Loyola.

Series 10: Restricted, 1974-1982, Box 21

This series contains student grades and Festle's personal information.
