Scope and Content

The Holy Family Parish records consist of 67 ledgers in 53 phase boxes (7.0 linear feet) spanning the years 1857 to 1951 and include minutes, announcements, hymns, membership lists, tuition and student lists, and booklets. Subjects include Holy Family Parish, Sodality, Acolytes (Mass servers), choir, Society of Living Rosary, purgatorial Society, and clubs.
