

## **APPLICATION DAYS AND THREE FREE FLIGHTS**

### **Raffle Restrictions**

**Eligible Programs:** Winners of the flight raffle may only use the flight voucher for the following Loyola-run study abroad programs. Summer 2012: Rome Center (Session I, II, or both); Mallorca, Spain; Aix-en-Provence, France; Tunisia; Peru Service-learning; Beijing Center; & Wroclaw, Poland. Fall 2012: Loyola Vietnam Program. The flight voucher **may not** be used for summer programs held at the Rome Center by specific schools (i.e. School of Education, School of Business Administration, etc.).

**Who May Enter:** Any full-time Loyola undergraduate student may enter the raffle to win a free round-trip flight to select study abroad programs. Though all students may enter the raffle regardless of their current application status (i.e. whether they have already been accepted, applied or have yet to apply), the winners of the flight raffle must apply, be accepted and participate in one of the selected programs during summer or fall 2012 in order to use the flight voucher. Winners who do not apply, get accepted or participate in an eligible program will forfeit their flight voucher.

**How to Enter & Winner Selection:** Eligible students may enter the raffle by completing a raffle entry card daily at the Application Days & Three Free Flights tables in the fourth floor of the Information Commons Monday, February 20-Wednesday, February 22 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Students must be present to enter the raffle and may not submit a raffle entry on behalf of another student. Only one entry per person per day is permitted. Any duplicate entry will void the student's eligibility for the raffle. One flight raffle winner will be drawn at random from entries each day of the event at 2 p.m. Winners will be notified by phone and/or email. Raffle entries submitted will only be eligible to win that day. Students must enter daily for a chance to win that day's flight.

**Flight Voucher:** Winners of the raffle will receive a flight voucher to purchase their study abroad program flight through Heritage Travel Agency. Winners will not be able to coordinate purchase of their ticket through Heritage Travel Agency until Loyola's Office for International Programs has informed Heritage Travel Agency that the student has been accepted to one of the select programs. The maximum value of the flight voucher is \$1,000. Winners who select a flight whose cost is in excess of \$1,000 will be responsible for the difference and will pay that additional cost directly to Heritage Travel Agency. Winners who select a flight whose cost is less than \$1,000 will not receive a credit or any compensation for the remaining value of the flight voucher that is unused. As flight tickets issued by Heritage Travel Agency to raffle winners will be non-refundable and non-transferable, a student who wins the raffle but does not participate in their designated study abroad program will be required to refund the cost of the ticket to Loyola's Office for International Programs. Flights that winners coordinate with Heritage Travel Agency must be in accordance with the arrival and departure policy or instructions of the study abroad program.
