Service Learning:

<u>PROGRAM TYPE</u>	<u>COUNTRY</u>	<u>PROGRAM LENGTH</u>	<u>SCOPE OF SERVICE</u>
LUC	Vietnam	Semester	This course explores the concept of development and its impact on everyday lives of average Vietnamese through service-learning placements in the local community.
LUC	Peru	Summer	This course provides an opportunity to learn about the cultural and political practices of popular sectors that shape "barrios" (shantytowns) in Lima while participating in ongoing community-based programs. Students may choose a health, social service, or education-focused service-learning placement.
Affiliate - Casa de la Solidaridad	El Salvador (San Salvador)	Summer	Students will integrate classroom learning with experiential community-based learning in marginal Salvadoran communities. Each student will have a praxis site (field placement) where they will work 4 afternoons a week in either a hospital or clinic. These praxis sites will be supervised by medical professionals from in El Salvador. Students live in community with other Casa students as well as with peer Salvadoran scholarship students studying at the Jesuit-run Central American University (UCA). Field trips include: Major public hospitals, rural clinics, health cooperatives (dentistry, optomology, natural medicine).
Affiliate - Casa de la Solidaridad	El Salvador (San Salvador)	Semester	Students will integrate classroom learning with experiential community-based learning in marginal Salvadoran communities. Each student will work for two full days each week with that community for the entire semester. Site include: cooperatives, elementary schools, catholic charities.
Affiliate – Marquette Univ.	South Africa (Cape Town)	Semester	Service learning sites on this program provide opportunities to engage in community education, empowerment, mediation, training, research and more. Students work with local non-profits that address issues as diverse as HIV/AIDS and other health concerns, family violence, gender inequities, sustainable living, and the education and development of youth.
Affiliate: Universidad Alberto Hurtado	Chile (Santiago)	Semester	One of the program's core courses Poverty and Development in Latin America has a practical component where students have a project in a Chilean school, neighborhood center, or social service agency. This course has been approved to count toward the toward core curriculum requirements.
IES	South Africa (Cape Town)	Semester	Placements are available in non-governmental organizations and local businesses. Each placements is tied to an IES- South African-focused elective class that focus on health, history, management or sociology
IES	Ecuador (Quito)	Semester	Placements are available in social and health-related organizations (examples: Museo Mindalea, CARE-Ecuador, Ecuadorian Red Cross).
IES	Spain (Barcelona)	Semester	Placements working with children and on social responsibility issues.
IES	India (Delhi)	Semester	Placements in organizations that deal with environmental issues, social and child welfare, economic development, health, housing, rural development, nutrition, cultural heritage, and animal welfare.
