Time: Check-in for pre-registered participants opens at 9:00 a.m. on Halas Field (rain location: Gentile). The 5K walk starts at 10:00 a.m.

Location/Course: The walk course will take a scenic tour through the Rogers Park and Edgewater neighborhood before entering the lakefront path. .
