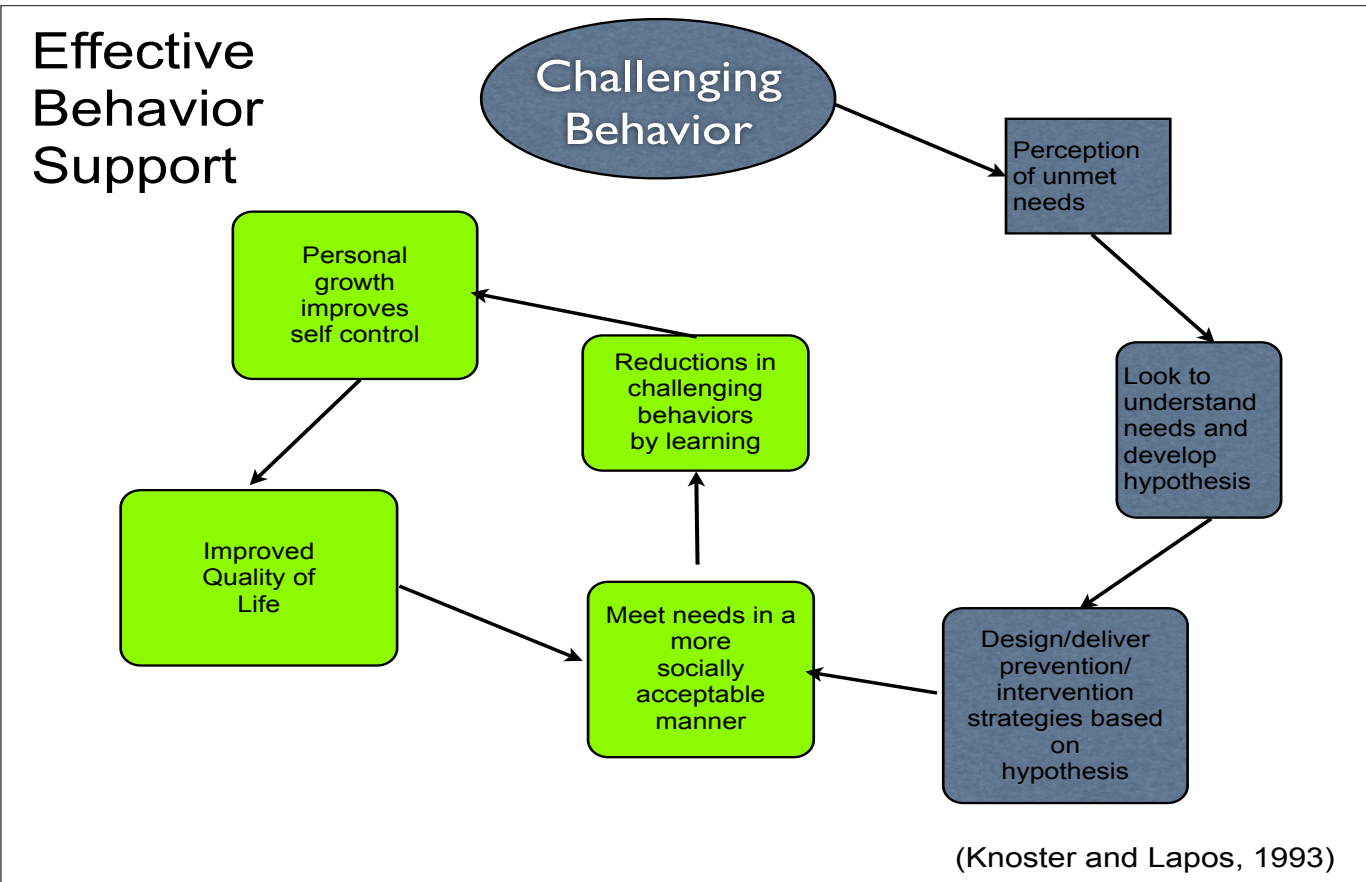
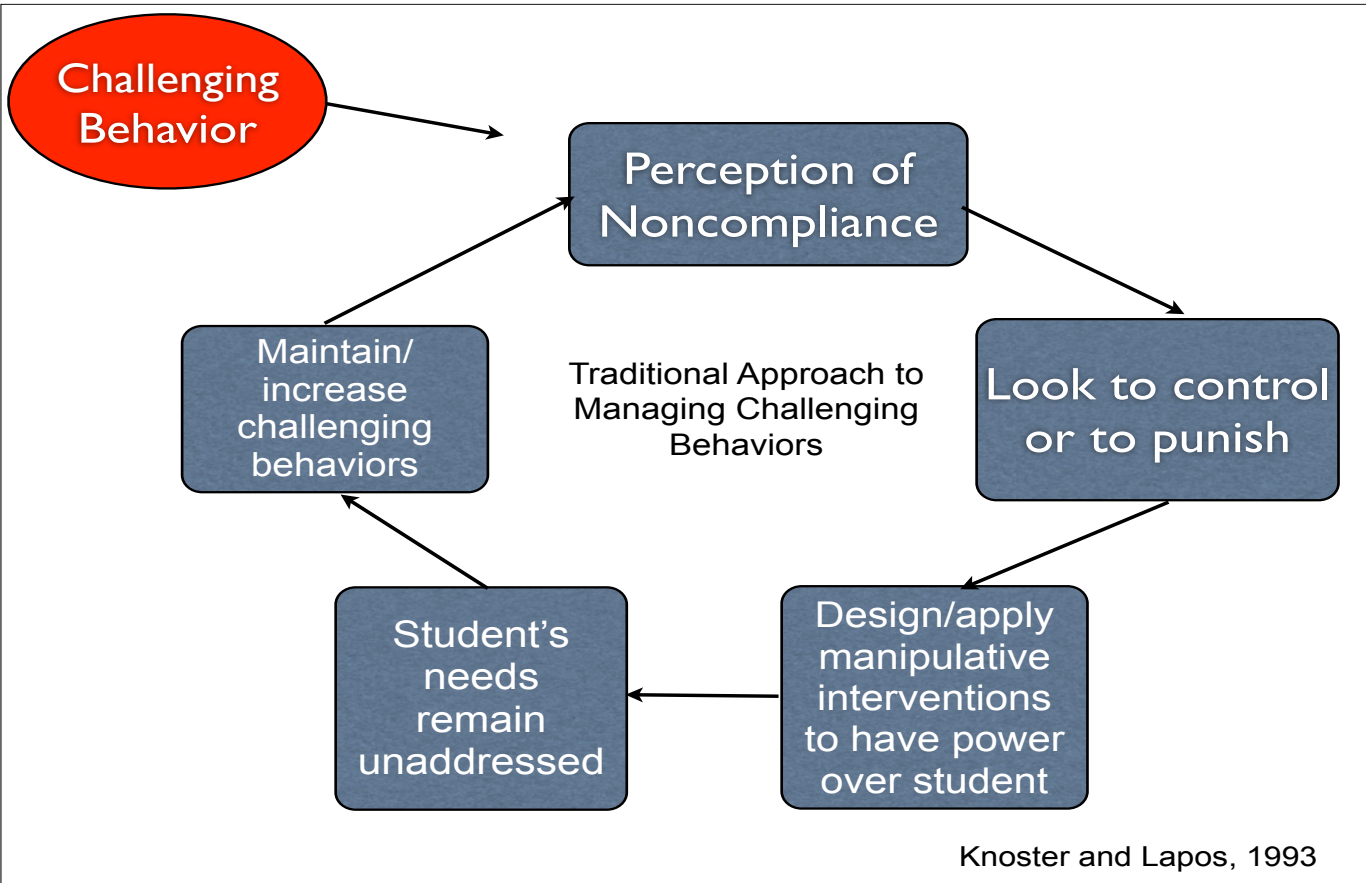

BE SAFE	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Stay seated at all times (back to back, bottom to seat, backpacks on lap) Enter/exit carefully Use quiet voices on the bus Keep hands, feet, objects to yourself Open windows to line only (do not put anything out the window) Carry all backpacks on and off the bus (handles must be collapsed) No open food or drink on the bus. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Keep hands and feet to yourself Do not go into the street for any reason Stay on the sidewalk at your bus stop Get on and off only at your assigned stop 	<p>Arrival inside the school:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Go to designated areas promptly Put belongings in correct places Report to office when arriving late <p>Dismissal:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Promptly exit assigned doors and walk directly home, to bus, or after school activity Report to office if ride home is late <p>Mid-day Release:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Report to office for sign out 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Use facilities appropriately Wash hands with soap Turn off faucet Walk back to class Use bathroom at appropriate times 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Walk everywhere Stay seated Clean up properly Be responsible for your own food items
BE RESPECTFUL	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Take your seat quickly Listen to the bus driver, patrols, and supervisors. Slide in and let others sit Use kind words when speaking to others 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Respect the personal property of others Respect others as you board and exit the bus 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Respond to patrols and adults Use indoor voices when entering building. Remove hats when entering school. Use kind words when speaking to others. Respect personal space and belongings. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Respect your privacy Give others privacy Flush toilet after use Use one paper towel and put in trash Keep bathroom clean Be silent 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Inside voices Follow directions Wait your turn in line Listen to lunchroom supervisors Use good table manners Take turns washing tables Ask for bathroom privileges
