- 1) Previous Meeting Minutes Approval.
  - a) The Committee unanimously approved the minutes from its November 19, 2004 meeting.
- 2) Certification Self-Study Project Update and Sports Program Update.
  - a) John updated the Intercollegiate Athletics Advisory Committee on the status of Loyola's Certification Self-Study Report and the timetable for the NCAA site visit. He followed with an overview of the various sports programs and how their seasons have progressed to date.
- 3) FAR Update.
  - a) Brian discussed the 2004 NCAA Drug and Alcohol Study and provided each member with the survey instrument that was completed this past December by members from four randomly selected Loyola sports teams. The Committee then discussed the reported findings from the NCAA Gender Equity Study and the NCAA Sports Gambling Study. Brian closed with an update on issues addressed at the National FAR meeting held in November 2004.
- 4) SAAC Update.
  - a) Lee provided the Committee members with an update on SAAC activities since the last Committee meeting. He also discussed SAAC's initiative to sponsor an end-of-year sports banquet.
- 5) Student-Athlete Advising.
  - a) Phyllis discussed the plans for an upcoming athlete awards recognition event for student-athletes with a 3.0 or better GPA. She then emphasized that the Loyola student-athlete population has achieved a 3.0 or better GPA for the past five years.

- 6) NCAA Certification Self-Study Project and its Impact on the Intercollegiate Athletic Advisory Committee.
  - a) Brian distributed to each committee member a spreadsheet that highlighted future responsibilities for the Intercollegiate Athletic Advisory Committee as noted in the recently completed NCAA Certification Self-Study Report. Advisory Committee members agreed that four separate sub-committees (Academic Integrity, Gender Equity, Minority Issues, and Student-Welfare) were necessary to provide an ongoing review of Loyola University's commitment to the areas of Academic Integrity and Equity, Welfare, and Sportsmanship. Sub-committee members will be identified by the time the Committee meets in April.
- 7) Future Meeting Date.
  - a) The Committee agreed that its next meeting would be held on Thursday, April 7 at 3:00pm in the Ireland Room. Additional meetings will be scheduled if necessary. An e-mail reminding members of the April meeting will be sent by the Committee Chair.
