FALL 2008**

Students will work together to edit, design and publish an edition of *Stateville Speaks*, written in collaboration with current Illinois prisoners about topics in criminal justice and prison life.

In this class you will:

- Work in teams to plan, design, edit and write the new *Stateville Speaks*.
- Correspond with prisoners who are reporting from within Illinois prisons.
- Facilitate meetings and make work presentations.
- Participate in discussions about issues in the U.S. prison system—including the death penalty, solitary confinement, juvenile justice, sentencing guidelines, and ex-offender restrictions.
- Hear remarkable guest lectures from ex-prisoners, attorneys, and activists, as well as faculty in Criminal Justice, Journalism, Sociology, and Fine and Performing Arts.
