## Isotherms

- 1.5 The following map shows the actual temperatures observed at 7:00 A.M. on a day in early April. Draw the necessary *isotherms* to show the temperature pattern at that time. Use a  $10^{\circ}\text{F}$  interval. Be sure to draw your isotherms *lightly in pencil* so that you may later eliminate unwarranted wiggles or kinks and poor spacing. Only when your isotherms are absolutely correct should you go over them to darken them. All isotherms should be labeled, and the labels should be kept in the same general region on the map, if possible.
