

Parent Survey Tool
Training Talking Points

The following are points that could be made when providing training for coaches and teams regarding the use of the ASPIRE Parent Survey.

- This tool focuses on participation more than satisfaction.
- This tool is designed to be used with parents or guardians of children receiving tier three supports.
- Based on recent experiences with this tool, it is best to have someone with whom the parent or guardian is familiar to support (e.g., introduce, read) the completion of the survey.
- It may be best to provide a quiet place for the parent or guardian to complete the survey immediately following the problem solving meeting.
- It is best to aggregate these data at the building level.
- Parent level data can be powerful motivators for policy and funding systems change. The data that are generated from this survey may provide a useful conduit for creating change in resource allocation for three-tiered intervention, in particular at the tertiary level.
