ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all currently enrolled Loyola University Chicago students. All works must be original and completed within the last year.

MEDIA AND SPECIFICATIONS:

Open to visual art media including: painting, drawing, photography, printmaking, sculpture, ceramics, metals, and design. Works that are performance- or installation-based or computer-displayed are not eligible. Work must not exceed 36 inches in any dimension. Maximum weight of sculpture must not exceed 50 lbs.

JUROR:

Mary Lou Zelazny is an adjunct professor of painting and drawing at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago.

AWARDS:

1st, 2nd, 3rd place, and Honorable Mention awards will be given during the opening reception on February 19, 5:30-7:30pm.

PRESENTATION OF COMPETITION ENTRIES:

Submit 1-3 pieces of original artwork. Each piece should be labeled with the student's name, title of the piece, and medium on the back or bottom of the artwork.

Photos, drawings, prints and related 2D works must be properly matted with a white or neutral mat with a protective acetate covering. Work should NOT be framed nor wired. All works must be ready for exhibition. The Gallery Coordinator and Juror retain the right to exclude work not professionally presented or not conforming to the prospectus guidelines.

SELECTION PROCESS:

This exhibition will be juried from actual work. Students may enter up to three works for consideration.

HAND DELIVERIES/RETURN OF WORK:

Only work that is dropped-off at the Mundelein 9th floor Fine Arts Faculty Office on February 1st-4th from 10am-4pm will be juried. Late submissions will not be considered. Works not selected for the exhibition must be picked up at the Mundelein 9th floor Fine Arts Faculty Office on February 22. Selection for the exhibition will be announced through campus email and by phone. At the close of the exhibition, accepted works must be picked up in the Ralph Arnold Annex April 19-23. Work not picked up by the 23rd will become the property of the Department of Fine Arts and disposed of as it is deemed appropriate.

EXHIBITION:

All work must remain in the Ralph Arnold Annex until the close of the exhibition on April 16.

LIABILITY:

All reasonable effort and care will be given for the works while in the care of the Ralph Arnold Annex. Limited insurance for the replacement of materials is provided in the event of loss or damage of works while on display in the Ralph Arnold Annex.

SALES & REPRODUCTION:

No commission is charged for the sale of work. Any inquiries will be directed to the artist. Entrants agree to allow accepted work to be reproduced as necessary for publication/promotion purposes.
