### **Scholarship Information/Current Students**

The School Education announces a scholarship in memory of Dr. Anna Lowe, a long-time faculty member in teacher preparation. The biennial scholarship of \$10,000 will be awarded to an education student of junior status.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- ◆ Declared major in the School of Education
- ◆ Junior status at time of award
- ◆ An essay describing his/her interest in education and African American, Heritage, and Culture Studies and how those studies will impact his/her future role as an educator
- ◆ Two letters of recommendation from faculty

#### **SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:**

- ◆ Demonstrates an interest in education and African American Studies, or Heritage and Cultural Studies
- ◆ Meets the School of Education GPA requirements: a cumulative GPA of 2.5 and a major GPA of 2.8.
- ◆ FAFSA form on file with the LUC Office of Student Financial Assistance.

#### **APPLICATION PROCEDURES:** To apply for the Anna Lowe Memorial Scholarship

- ◆ Complete the attached application by **February 15**.
- ◆ Write an essay describing your interest in education and African American Studies, or Heritage and Cultural Studies and how those studies will impact your role as a future educator
- ◆ Submit two letters of recommendation from Loyola faculty.
