1. Please record a vote in both categories, A and B.
 2. A vote of 3 under A together with any vote under B requires that the oral defense be repeated, with re-voting.
 3. A vote of 2 under B places final responsibility for monitoring proposed changes in the hands of the Director of the dissertation; no re-voting required.
 4. Voting No. 3 under B expresses intention that the dissertation be re-circulated to the full committee in its revised form for re-voting.
 5. In the case of a five or more person board, at least four “favorable” votes (No. 1 or No. 2 under A or B) are required for passing. Only one “dissenting” vote (No. 3 under A or B) is permissible. All other committees require unanimous “favorable” votes for passing.
