- The Annual Meeting, held in St. Louis on the weekend closest to September 26, the poet's birthday.

The principal event of the occasion is the invitational Eliot Memorial Lecture. This has been presented, in recent years, by such scholars and poets as Michael Levenson, Helen Vendler, Geoffrey Hill, and Marjorie Perloff. Meetings have also included panels of Society members offering briefer papers, as well as book exhibits, music, and special tours of local sites associated with the young Eliot.

- Sessions at the American Literature Association conference, the annual convention of the Modern Language Association, and the Louisville Conference on Literature and Culture since 1900.
- Publication of *Time Present*, the Society's newsletter (three issues annually).
