### Ensuring success at work and at home

The newest Center program, the Family Business Stewardship Institute (FBSI), prepares family business owners, shareholders, and stakeholders (including non-owner spouses and future owners) for effective stewardship of their family enterprises. This comprehensive educational curriculum addresses the major competencies needed for effective family business ownership. The goal of the program is to prepare stakeholders—both financial and emotional—for the significant and sometimes unpredictable transitions and decisions that must be made to determine the success and continuity of the family business.

Each of the six modules are made up of two- to three-day sessions taught by Loyola faculty and nationally recognized family business thought leaders. Continued online education, connection with fellow students, and networking opportunities that follow are what really help participants apply the knowledge they've learned once they return to their businesses. In addition, participants form a lifelong network of professionals, who, like themselves, face similar challenges. Certificates are given to those who complete each facet of the program.
