The new Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program provides up to \$4,000 per year in for graduate and undergraduate students who intend to **teach full-time in high-need subject areas** for at least **four years at schools that serve students from low-income families**. Students may receive up to \$16,000 for undergraduate study and up to \$ 8,000 for graduate study. Part-time students are eligible, but the maximum grant will be reduced.

Students who do not complete the teaching commitment required will have the grant converted to an Unsubsidized Federal Stafford Loan. Based on meeting the following criteria, I request consideration for the TEACH Grant for 2009-2010:

- I plan to teach in one of the high-need subject areas (Bilingual Education and English Language Acquisition, Foreign Language, Mathematics, Reading Specialist, Science, Special Education, or another teacher shortage area listed in the Department of Education’s Annual Teacher Shortage Area Nationwide Listing),
- I have a cumulative GPA (or transfer/high school GPA for new students) of 3.25, or scored above the 75th percentile on a college admissions test (e.g. SAT, ACT), and
- I am enrolled in a TEACH Grant-eligible Teacher Preparation program,
