Dawn A. Harris is the Director at the Gannon Center for Women and Leadership. She served as the Assistant Provost for International Initiatives from 2006 to 2008 and as the Associate Dean of Academic Affairs at the School of Business Administration from 2004 until 2006 at Loyola University Chicago. She was Chair of the Management Department from 2001 until 2004.
