

## **“Loyola Gives” Instructions**

Our family consists of the Mother, 2 teenagers, and 3 children under 10yrs old. The guidelines suggest that we spend \$100 per person which would be \$600 total. While this may seem like a lot, this is more than possible. We have roughly 1,300 graduate students. If every grad student gives just \$0.47 we can provide a great Christmas for this family that would otherwise not have been possible. There are many ways we can accomplish this goal. ### **Option 1**

Your department/program can be responsible for a family member. There is a list for each family member of what they would like (i.e., winter coat, stuffed animal, barbies, etc.) Then drop off your unwrapped gift items on Wednesday, December 9 in Centennial Forum Student Union from 12-2pm.

### **Options 2**

Cash donations will be accepted in the Graduate School, 4th floor Granada Center, LSC. Cash donations should be made no later than December 2<sup>nd</sup>. A group of graduate students will purchase gifts and food items for the family on Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup>.

### **Option 3**

Donate you time and report to Centennial Forum Student Union, Bremner Lounge, LSC on Wednesday, December 9<sup>th</sup> to help organize the gifts.
