3. **Advanced** means you can complete an elective course from that same Area of Study in place of the fundamental core course. For example; a student Advanced out of ACCT 400 can take an elective course from the Accounting Area of Study.
4. **Substitution** means a student may take a course in any area to fulfill the fundamental core requirement.
5. The initial integrative experience must be taken after a student has completed all of his or her fundamental core courses.
