- Essay (500 words typed) on the following topic: How has a book or film changed your life philosophy?
- List of activities and achievements requested in Part I below
- A brief answer (100 words typed) to the leadership question in Part II below
- Faculty recommendation: Please return in a signed and sealed envelope with your application.
- An official copy of your high-school transcript
