## Loyola's RSS News Feed

Now you can automatically receive the latest news and events taking place at Loyola by subscribing to Loyola's RSS news feed. When you subscribe to the feed using your web browser or a web-based feed reader such as [Bloglines](#), you will get the most updated items from the Loyola University Chicago Newsroom, including the weekly ITS Technology Tips. The benefit of a feed subscription is that you can receive the most up to date information without having to remember to visit numerous links and individual websites.

### How to Subscribe to Loyola's RSS News Feed

Go to [Loyola's home page](#); scroll down to the bottom right hand corner of the page and click the RSS Feed button.



You can subscribe to RSS feeds using the latest versions of the following web browsers: Internet Explorer 7, Firefox 2.0 or Safari 2.0. Instructions are provided on how to subscribe to feeds using your Web browser in this previous Loyola tech tip:
