SUBMISSION RULES

The speakers of the afternoon session on April 17, 2009 shall be selected from among the researchers who shall submit their paper summaries and outlines to the Organisation Committee to be graded by the Assessment Board. The applications should be submitted as follows.

The summaries and outlines of the papers should be sent to the Organisation Committee by 17 November 2008 as an e-mail attachment in Word format to the following address: rekabet@erciyes.edu.tr (Please demand a message confirming receipt of your e-mail.) The text should be in Times New Roman format, 12 fonts, single-spaced. The summary shall be maximum 300 words and the outline, maximum one page. The topic of the paper should be clearly stated and three keywords should be given. The name and surname, title and the work address should be stated.

The Board members shall assess the summaries individually and shall send the names of the five summaries which they rank top, to the Organisation Committee in order. The summary that ranks top shall receive 5 points and the summaries shall be given points in descending order until where the summary ranking fifth shall be given 1 point. The top three papers to be invited for presentation shall be determined pursuant to the total number of points they get. (The summaries shall be sent to the Board members without the name of their authors. The grading list shall be sent to the applicants on request.) The results shall be announced by mid-November.

The top three researchers shall be invited to present their papers. In order to confirm the invitation, the full text of the papers should be sent to the Organisation Committee by 2 February 2009, either in English or Turkish, together with a statement transferring the relevant publication rights to Erciyes University and the Turkish Competition Authority. It should be borne in mind that the time allocated for the presentation each paper is 30 min. Failure to send the paper by that date shall result in the cancellation of the invitation and the next ranking researcher shall then be invited. The travel and accomodation expenses of the speakers shall be covered. The researchers who have sent their summaries and yet who have not been selected may also send their papers to be published in the Symposium Book, provided that the paper is approved by the Assessment Board.
