

**CHILE STUDY TOUR 2012  
SAMPLE STUDENT BUDGET (TENTATIVE)**

This budget assumes that the student leaves the U.S. on the evening of Saturday, March 3, arriving in Santiago on Sunday, March 4 (the absolute deadline for arrival), and that the student leaves Chile on the evening of Saturday, March 10, arriving in the U.S. on Sunday, March 11. (The program officially ends in the late afternoon on Friday, March 9.) Arrival or departure on different dates will incur different costs.

Air fare	\$1,500*	\$1,500
Chile airport tax	\$132	132
Room	\$68**/night (6 nights), incl. brkft. =	408
Activity fee	\$200	200
Food	\$250-300***	300
TOTAL		<u>\$2,540</u>

\* Approximate. Students are often creative in securing lower air fares. Some students use frequent flyer miles.

\*\* The cost of the room has been about \$135 per night, double occupancy (students sharing a room). Students who request a single room will pay the full cost of about \$135 per night.

\*\*\* This is an approximation of the average student expenditure for regular meals during the week in Chile.
