Wally Bobkiewicz is the City Manager of Evanston, Illinois, a community of 75,000 located just north of Chicago. Mr. Bobkiewicz serves as the Chief Executive Officer of the city with an annual budget of \$235 million and 850 employees.

Before beginning his current position in August, 2009, Mr. Bobkiewicz was the City Manager of Santa Paula, California for seven years and Assistant City Manager in Novato, California for four and a half years. Prior to that, Bobkiewicz served the City of Long Beach, California for nine years as Telecommunications Manager, Assistant to the City Manager, and as an Administrative Analyst in the Public Works and Police Departments.

Wally earned a Master's degree in Public Administration from the Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs at Syracuse University and a Bachelor of Science degree in Public Administration from the University of Southern California.
