UNIV 290: Seminar in Community-Based Service and Leadership	Meet on a weekly basis	Seminar course exploring the theory and practice of community-based service and leadership through service-learning	40-50 volunteer hours at an “approved” site	Non-profit organization with whom student has made previous arrangements.
UNIV 390: Internship Seminar in Organizational and Community Leadership	Meet 5 times a semester	Involves readings, reflection assignments, and building an electronic portfolio to support your internship experience in the context of organizational leadership and community development theory	100+ hours over a semester at an “approved” internship or student employment position	Business, non-profit organization, government agency, with whom student has made previous arrangements.
UNIV 391: Internship Seminar in Undergraduate Research	Meet on a bi- weekly basis	Students will reflect on the research experience in the context of understanding research paradigms, application of research methodologies, understanding the implications of ethical research and preparing to present research professionally	5-10 hours per week of research with an “approved” mentor & project	With faculty/mentor with whom student has made previous arrangements.
