**Biographical History**

Carolyn Farrell, B.V.M., was born in Des Moines, Iowa, on November 2, 1934, to parents James (Les) and Catherine Farrell. The oldest of six children, Carolyn attended Holy Trinity elementary school and St. Joseph Academy in Des Moines, Iowa. In 1953, at the age of 18, Carolyn entered the Sisters of Charity of the Blessed Virgin Mary (B.V.M.) congregation in Dubuque, Iowa.

While at the motherhouse in Dubuque, Carolyn received both her college education and religious training. She was professed in 1956 as Sister Mary Lester, B.V.M., taking her final vows on July 16, 1961. In 1966 she received a Bachelor of Arts degree in History from Clarke College. In addition, Carolyn holds a Master of Science in Education Administration from Western Illinois University. She has done post-graduate work at the University of Iowa in Administration of Higher Education, and in Public Policy at the Hubert Humphrey Institute for Public Affairs at the University of Minnesota.

From 1956 to 1969 Carolyn held various teaching positions at St. Paul the Apostle in Davenport, Iowa, and St. Tarcissus in Chicago, Illinois. She served as the Principal of St. Patrick's Catholic

School in Dubuque from 1969 to 1974. In 1974, Carolyn joined the staff of Clarke College as Director of Special Programs. In 1977, she became Dean of Continuing Education at Clarke, a position she held until 1988.

Two major events took place in 1974 that led to her interest in the City Council at Dubuque, Iowa. First, the Mayor of Dubuque asked Carolyn to serve on the Dubuque Civil Service Commission. Secondly, the Governor of Iowa invited her to serve on the Iowa 2000 Task Force Committee studying Iowa's potential for the Year 2000. While serving on these committees, she discovered a desire to become more active in the political process. As a result, she decided to run for election to the City Council. Although other women had run for council member, Carolyn was the first to be elected to a four-year term in November 1977. Of the nine candidates running, she finished first in the primary voting and first in the general election.

Carolyn's election to the City Council of Dubuque set a precedent for women and women religious around the country. Because of the unique structure of the Dubuque City Council, the five council members are required to elect one of their own to serve as Mayor for one year each January. Carolyn was elected Mayor of Dubuque on January 7, 1980 and became the first woman religious to serve as the mayor of a city.

Carolyn did not run for re-election to the City Council when her term ended in the fall of 1981, electing instead to continue as the Director of Continuing Education at Clarke College until 1988. During this time, Carolyn held various positions in the B.V.M. Congregation. Following a sabbatical at the Hubert Humphrey Public Policy Institute, she was selected as the first coordinator of the B.V.M. Women's Office to be established in Minneapolis, Minnesota in June 1989.

In February 1991, Carolyn accepted the Interim Presidency of Mundelein College in Chicago, Illinois. As President, she was chief negotiator with the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Loyola University Chicago to achieve the Memorandum of Agreement between Mundelein College and Loyola University Chicago, signed in June 1991, which brought about the affiliation of Mundelein College with Loyola University Chicago. She then went on to serve as Associate Vice President of Loyola University for Mundelein College and Associate Vice President and Director of the Ann Ida Gannon, BVM, Center for Women and Leadership. At the same time she attended the United Nations 4<sup>th</sup> World Conference on Women in Beijing. Farrell retired from Loyola University Chicago in 2006 and continues her work as Director of the Roberta Kuhn Center at the BVM Motherhouse in Dubuque, Iowa.

### **Scope and Content**

The contents of this collection are strictly related to Farrell's professional life and activities. It is organized by professional affairs including BVM activities, Political life, the Mundelein College President Office, Loyola University and Mundelein College affairs, and her participation in the United Nations 4<sup>th</sup> World Conference on Women in Beijing. The collection also includes AV materials, oversized materials, 3D objects, and a small monograph collection. The dates of the collection span 1942-2006, however the bulk of the dates are 1977-1996. The collection is organized alphabetically and chronologically in case of correspondence. This collection heavily consists of correspondence which can be found throughout.

**Series 1: BVM and other Activities, 1953-2006, n.d., Boxes 1-3**

Contains materials related to Farrell's role as a BVM and her participation in other professional activities and organization. This series includes correspondence and materials related but not limited to BVM Women's office, Clarke College, Dubuque, Iowa, travel, UNIFEM, and NAWCHE. The series is organized alphabetically.

**Series 2: Politics, 1977-2000, n.d., Boxes 3-5**

Contains newspaper articles, correspondence, and paperwork related to Farrell's terms as City Council member and Mayor of Dubuque, Iowa. This also includes a scrapbook and newspapers in the oversize materials. This series is organized alphabetically.

**Series 3: Mundelein College President Office, 1942-1995, n.d., Box 6-12**

Contains materials related to the administrative work of Mundelein Presidents prior to Farrell. This collection includes correspondence, alumnae information, and speeches. The series is organized alphabetically.

**Series 4: Loyola University and Mundelein College, 1984-2006, n.d., Box 13-17**

Contains materials pertaining to Farrell's position at Loyola University and Mundelein College. It includes correspondence, administrative paperwork, newspaper articles, and publications related to the affiliation and the Transition Advisory Committee, the establishment of the Ann Ida Gannon, BVM, Center for Women and Leadership and archives, and events sponsored by the Gannon Center and Loyola University. It includes an extensive collection of correspondence organized chronologically that pertains to the listed subjects and other matters related to Farrell during her tenure at Loyola University. The series is organized alphabetically.

**Series 5: United Nations 4<sup>th</sup> World Conference on Women in Beijing, 1984-2000, Box 17-21**

Contains materials related to Farrell's preparation, attendance, and post conference involvement. It includes correspondence, registration information, magazine and newspaper articles, conference materials, reading materials, pamphlets, notes, and souvenirs from Beijing. The series is organized alphabetically.

**Series 6: A.V. Materials, 1954-2005, Box 21-22**

Contains photographs, slides, cassettes, audio reel, and VHS which chronicle Farrell's professional life. They include images of BVMs, Dubuque politics, and Loyola.

**Series 7: Monographs, 1980-1989, Box 23**

Contains books related to Farrell or works in which she contributed.

**Series 8: 3D Objects and Oversized Materials, 1977-1995, n.d., Box 24-26**

Contains miscellaneous 3D objects from Dubuque politics and from Beijing. This series also includes oversize materials including a scrapbook, newspapers and magazines, and thank you notes.
