Dr. Luttenton represented the residents of Michigan in a 9-yr court battle against Nestle, Co. (owners of Ice Mountain bottled water) as they extracted excessive amounts of water from Michigan aquifers. These actions threatened the quality and quantity of residential well water and presented a significant stress to streams and wetlands within the affected watershed.
