

## **Training for Supervised Research Personnel**

All supervised research personnel are required to complete training before they can begin working with animals.

Principal Investigators should contact the ACF Supervisor, Trudy Powelson, to arrange for Supervised Research Personnel listed on their active protocols to take the Introductory Laboratory Animal Training Course. This course is designed to inform the individual about the potential health risks of working with laboratory animals.

Arrangements can also be made for additional species-specific training conducted by the ACF Supervisor.

The Principal Investigator is responsible for providing “technique” training, but these are only required if research personnel are involved with such techniques.

At the time of a new project submission or an annual renewal, the PI will be asked to list/update all research personnel associated with the project and the PI will need to submit documentation of completion for each individual listed.
