The editorial board anonymously reviews submissions and edits accepted papers with permission from the authors. Papers should be no longer than 20 double-spaced pages and submitted on a disk as a Microsoft Word document file (.doc). All identifying information, including contact information, should be on a separate page. Responsibility for accuracy of information contained in written submissions rests solely with the authors. Opinions expressed in the journal are those of the authors and do not necessarily reflect the views of the School of Social Work or the Editorial Board.
