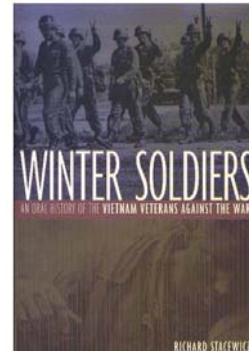
Spat-upon Veterans, Abandoned POWs, and Hanoi Jane: Vietnam and the Making of America’s “Great Betrayal Narrative”
