As part of the online application you must upload a copy of your valid passport or passport application receipt and pay by credit card a \$100 non-refundable Office for International Programs (OIP) study abroad fee.

This three-and-a-half week summer program in Aix-en-Provence is an intensive immersion experience. Students are taught by resident French faculty at all levels, from elementary French to advanced courses in culture and civilization. Students receive six credit hours. Program housing is available at a residence hotel near campus in shared suites that include a private kitchenette and bathroom. Students may also opt for greater cultural immersion by choosing a homestay. A Loyola University Chicago faculty administrator is available at all times to accompany students on numerous excursions and cultural events, and to ensure the success of their experience in France.

COURSE OFFERINGS:***FREN 101/102: Introductory French***

Prerequisite: No previous knowledge of French. This course includes language instruction with developing proficiency in oral expression. (6 credit hours)

FREN 103/104: Intermediate French

Prerequisite: One year of college French or the equivalent. This course includes an intensive review of the basic skills to develop audio-lingual facility in communication. (6 credit hours)

FREN 250/251: Composition & Conversation

Prerequisite: Two years of previous study at the college level. The course will help students develop greater fluency in speech and writing. (6 credit hours)

FREN 300: Tutorial for Credit

(6 credit hours)

NOTE: Students are not restricted to combining courses in the pairs indicated above. For example, a student may take FREN 102 & 103 or FREN 104 & 250 or FREN 251 & 300 if that is where they are in their sequence of French coursework. However, classes taken must total 6 credit hours.
