PROGRAM FEE OF \$1,750 INCLUDES:

- Two meals per day
- Tour of historic Palma and two academic excursions across the island of Mallorca

TUITION FEE OF \$3,630 INCLUDES:

- 6 credit hours of Loyola summer session tuition

PROGRAM DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- Round-trip airfare (Chicago to Mallorca)
- Bus pass in Mallorca
- Personal spending money
- Baggage insurance and excess baggage fees
- Other incidental expenses
- Travel insurance
- International health insurance (required to be purchased separately)

This four-week program provides students with a unique opportunity to study at the Universitat de les Illes Balears (UIB) on the island of Mallorca, a multicultural and bilingual region of Spain (Catalan and Spanish). Students will have the opportunity to improve their Spanish language skills outside the classroom by living with a welcoming local host family or señora. Homestays are located both within the Palma city center and in the surrounding neighborhoods. Hosts provide students with two meals per day (breakfast and dinner Monday-Friday, breakfast and lunch or dinner on weekends). In their free time, students can enjoy the expansive beaches, mountains and natural beauty that the island of Mallorca provides.

COURSE OFFERINGS:

Students take one 3-credit language course (offered at six different levels to fulfill SPAN 102-300) and one 3-credit content course from the following choices:

- Spanish Politics and Society (SPAN 390)
- Spanish Culture (SPAN 390)
- Golden Age Literature
- Introduction to Spanish Literature from the Middle Ages to 1700 (SPAN 270) taught by Loyola Prof. Alrick Knight.

All applications must be accompanied by a \$100 non-refundable deposit (which goes towards program costs) and a copy of a valid passport or receipt from passport application.
