

Study Abroad Course Approval Form

Course approvals for major, minor and Core credit are required prior to departure. This completed form must be on file with your academic advisor to receive credit for study abroad.

Step By Step Process:

- 1) **Schedule a meeting:** Have major and minor courses approved first *THEN* have core course approved. Make an appointment with the appropriate major, minor or Core approver (see box below). Take this form in to your appointment along with the necessary course descriptions or syllabi.
- 2) **Prepare for your meeting:** Review the courses offered on your program; find course syllabi or course descriptions for the classes you want to take; know what major, minor or Core requirements you are trying to fulfill; if you are going on a direct enroll or exchange program make sure to know the credit values of each course (OIP can provide assistance if necessary).
- 3) **Complete the process:** Once you have obtained all the necessary signatures, make two copies of this form: one for your academic advisor and one for the Office for International Programs. Keep the original for your own records.

Major or Minor Course Approvers:

Major Department Chair (or designee) may approve courses toward major.

Minor Department Chair (or designee) may approve courses toward minor.
