LIMA, PERU — SERVICE-LEARNING PROGRAM

May 23-July 3, 2010

Organized by the Office for International Programs in conjunction with the Universidad Antonio Ruiz de Montoya (UARM).

PROGRAM FEE OF \$1,465 INCLUDES:

- Homestay with a local Peruvian family or señora
- Three meals per day (with some exceptions)
- Two overnight weekend excursions to Chinchapisco-Paracas and to Ticio-Tarma-San Ramón
- Group activities and excursions in Lima
- On-site program support from UARM
- \$100 Loyola Office for International Programs study abroad fee

TUITION FEE OF \$3,630 INCLUDES:

- 6 credit hours of Loyola summer session tuition

OPTIONAL MACHU PICCHU TRIP FEE OF \$730 INCLUDES:

- Round-trip airfare from Lima to Cuzco
- 4 nights accommodation
- Tours of Cuzco and other historic sites
- Visit to Machu Picchu
- On-site support from UARM representative

PROGRAM DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- Round-trip airfare (Chicago to Lima)
- Personal spending money/incidental expenses
- Optional travel or baggage insurance/fees
- International health insurance (required to be purchased separately)

This program is a unique opportunity for any student that seeks an immersion experience in a Latin American country. During the first week of this six-week program, students have an intensive Spanish language tutorial and cultural activities meant to prepare them for the rest of the program. During the next five weeks, students divide their time with two days a week at their service placement and three days a week in class. After the program is completed students have the option to participate in a five-day trip to Cuzco and Machu Picchu.

COURSE OFFERINGS:

Students will enroll in both courses below and earn six credit hours in total. Students will be taught by professors from the Universidad Antonio Ruiz de Montoya.

UNIV 292 International Service Learning: Urban Popular Culture, Inclusion, and Service in Peru

- Learn about the cultural and political practices that shape the “barrios” (shantytowns) in Lima while participating in community-based programs.
- Choose from a placement in the education, health or social service field.

Contemporary Peru: Politics & Society

- Learn how social, cultural, and economic structures shape political developments in developing countries like contemporary Peru.
- Fulfills the Core Societal & Cultural Knowledge Area.

All applications must be accompanied by a \$100 non-refundable deposit and a copy of a valid passport or receipt from passport application.

Prerequisite: All participants must have completed SPAN 102 or the equivalent to participate. While classes are taught in English, students will have the opportunity to build Spanish language skills at their placements sites and with their host family.
