Biography

Anne E. Patrick, SNJM, PhD, is a Laird Professor of Religion and the Liberal Arts (Emerita) at Carleton College of Northfield, Minnesota. A member of the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary since 1960, Dr. Patrick has used her dedication in the secular realm as basis for her studies and professional writings in the discipline of Theology, specifically Feminist Theology as well as Religion and Literature.

Dr. Patrick earned four degrees: BA from Medaille College in Buffalo, New York (English, 1969); MA from University of Maryland (English, 1972); MA from the University of Chicago (Divinity, 1976); and PhD, focusing on Religion and Literature, from the University of Chicago (1982). Dr. Patrick has been an active lecturer and professor at such universities as University of Chicago Divinity School, University of Tulsa, and Carleton College—where she recently earned emeritus status. Patrick has been active in such associations as the Catholic Theological Society of American and the International Network of Societies for Catholic Theology, Society of Christian Ethics. Extensive essays and chapters by Dr. Patrick have been published in such journals as *New Catholic World* and *Commonweal* and monographs such as *Morphology of Faith and Ethical Dilemmas in the New Millenium*; she has published two monographs *Liberating Conscience: Feminist Explorations in Catholic Moral Theology* (1996) and *Women, Conscience, and the Creative Process* (2009).

Scope and Content

The papers of Anne E. Patrick, SNJM, PhD, span the years 1969-2009, have been divided into three series, and consist of Patrick's doctoral dissertation, publications in numerous periodicals and monographs, and a copy of her monograph *Liberating Conscience*. Documents from various conferences/ seminars and events at various educational institutions are also included.

Series 1: Academic, 1982, Box 1, contains a typewritten draft of Dr. Patrick's doctoral dissertation, "H. Richard Niebuhr's 'Ethics of Responsibility': A Resource for Literary Criticism."

Series 2: Professional, 1969-2009, n.d., Box 2-3, is composed of published articles, book reviews, monograph chapters and Patrick's first monograph, *Liberating Conscience*. There are also awards received by Patrick, as well as materials for seminars, workshops, and conferences attended by Patrick. A small amount of information about Patrick from excerpts in publications and programs by Carleton College and the Divinity School of University of Chicago is also included.

Series 3: Audiovisual, 1978-2009, n.d., Box 4, two audio cassettes of presentations by Dr. Patrick, two computer disks with files on *Liberating Conscience*, and a video disc of Dr. Patrick's Honors Convocation Speech given at Carleton College.
