She is the author of many books including *Elusive Equality: Women's Rights, Public Policy, and the Law; Transgender Rights: From Obama to Trump; Beyond Marriage: Continuing Struggles for LGBT Rights;* and *Pitiful Plaintiffs: Child Welfare Litigation and the Federal Courts*
