- Application review and endorsement.
  - Regardless if an ink or electronic signature is required, all applications must be submitted to ORS-RA prior to submission to an outside sponsor.
  - Please allow ample time to review, provide feedback, make corrections, etc., by submitting applications to ORS-RA no less than five (5) business days before the application is due.
- Application (form and budget) preparation
  - O Some departments have designated research administrators. For those who do not, ORS-RA can help prepare the form pages, budgets, and routing forms.

- All projects require a routing form (grants, contracts, in-house studies)
- LU number is automatically issued for identification and internal tracking
- Other items connected to (accessed through) the routing form include
  - o Conflict of Interest questionnaires (extramural funding)
  - o IRB application (human subjects)
  - o IACUC application (animal subjects)
  - o Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC) application (biohazardous materials)
- Agreements (non-disclosure, data use, material transfer, grant awards, subawards, contracts)
