Administrative History

James Wiser served as the Vice-President of Academic Affairs and Dean of Faculties from 1989 to 1997, replacing Alice Bourke Hayes. The title changed to Senior Vice-President of Academic Affairs in 1994, during Wiser's administration. Nina Appel served as the interim Senior Vice-President and Dean of Faculties from 1997 to 1998, when Dr. Lawrence Braskamp was appointed to the position. In 2003, the office of Senior Vice-President of Academic Affairs became the Office of the Provost.

Scope and Content

The records of the Senior Vice-President of Academic Affairs consist of 3.25 linear feet spanning the years 1983 to 1999. The collection includes administrative rules and procedures, financial records and planning documents, budgets, committee information and meeting minutes, and departmental information. Subjects include Dan Rostenkowski (D-IL), Mallinckrodt College, Mundelein College, and the Association of Jesuit Colleges and Universities.
