## **Administrative History**

Terence H. Ahearn, S.J., served as Regent of the Loyola University School of Medicine from 1931 to 1935. As the President's representative or deputy in the Medical School, the Regent oversaw financial transactions, supervised arrangements involving the use of the Medical School buildings or equipment, and served as a member of the Academic Council (see "Functions of Administrative Officers of Loyola University" Kane A2.1)

# **Scope and Content**

The following are the records of the Regent of the Loyola University School of Medicine, between 1925 and 1937, primarily those of Father Terence H. Ahearn, who served in this position from 1931 to 1935. These records contain surveys, reports, and correspondence, and are organized into two series.

#### Series 1: Survey of Loyola University School of Medicine, 1935

This series contains the survey of the Loyola Medical School conducted by the Council of Medical Education and Hospitals with the cooperation of the Association of American Medical Colleges and the Federation of State Medical Boards of the United States. Individual responses to Form C (faculty resumes) are distributed between Files 1-6 and 1-28, according to faculty member's department.

Series 2: General Files, 1925 to 1937
This series, pertaining to the daily operations of the Medical School, is arranged alphabetically and each file is ordered chronologically.
