Biographical Sketch

Thomas Carter was born on November 25, 1878. He received his B.S. at Loyola University and then a degree from Rush Medical College in 1906. He received an M.D. from Loyola Medical School in 1910. Carter started working at Loyola as an instructor of medicine in 1909 and remained at the university until 1916. Drafter for World War I in February 1918, he served as a 1st Lieutenant in U.S. Medical Corps and a ward surgeon at a base hospital in Nantes, France. He received his discharge from active duty in 1924.

After serving in the military, Carter returned to Chicago, where he began working at the Columbus Memorial Hospital. He wrote several medical papers and was especially known for discovering an antidote for bi-chloride mercury poisoning in 1913. Carter served as a member of several societies including the Chicago Medical Society, Illinois State Medical Society, and American Medical Association and Tri-State Medical Society. He was also a member of the Phi Delta Epsilon Fraternity and was chairman of the All-Chicago Kiwanis Clubs in the mid to late 1920s.

Scope and Content

The Thomas Carter Papers consist of 1.5 linear feet spanning the years 1909-1947 and include photographs, correspondence, newspapers, articles, programs, maps, medical journals, and reprints. Subjects include bi-chloride poisoning, surgery of the thyroid, Kiwanis Club, and the United States Military. Arrangement is chronological.

Series

Series 1: Personal Papers, 1909-1947, Undated. Boxes 1 & 3

Includes correspondence, newspaper clippings, memorabilia, a map, and photographs relating to Carter's personal life.

Series 2: Military Service, 1918-1927, Undated. Box 1

Includes correspondence, active duty assignments, medical forms and certifications, a record book, military event program schedules, and a letter, train tickets, and a map from his deployment in France.

Series 3: Medical Work, 1914-1930, Undated. Boxes 1-3

Includes Carter's publications on Bi-chloride poisoning treatment, medical addresses from Carter, medical discussions of his publications, medical journals, Carter's publications on surgery of the thyroid, a certificate for emergency relief units, medical association by-laws, and photographs.

Series 4: German Orphanage and Nursing Home, Undated. 1919, Box 2

Includes an anniversary booklet with information about the orphanage, a German newspaper published by the orphanage, and photos of orphans.
